

# DENTAL VENEERS OR CROWNS: WHICH OPTION IS BETTER?

Having a great smile can give a person the feeling of confidence and boost their self-esteem but if they have broken, discolored, or crooked teeth it can have the opposite effect. If you have any of these problems you can get back that great smile with the help of a [cosmetic dentist Near Me](#). There are a couple of methods in which the look of your teeth can be changed, which are dental crowns or dental veneers. Between the two there are similarities and differences.

## **Similarities:**

Both of these techniques are performed by using a custom-made casting of the patient's teeth in order to give them healthy, white teeth. The first thing **cosmetic dentist Uptown** does is take a mold of the tooth or teeth to be fixed and then send the mold to the dental laboratory.

This is so the dental veneers or crowns are customized to the patient's mouth. When the dentist at the **cosmetic dentist office** receives it back the molding is adhered to the patient's tooth using an adhesive. Both of these can withstand stains from cigarettes, tea, and coffee.

Both dental veneers and crowns price almost the same to have performed.



## Differences:

### Dental veneers:

- These will only mask the front of the tooth, the part that is exposed when the patient smiles.
- With a veneer, the density of the tooth only requires to be reduced by one millimeter or less because they only mask the front part of the tooth.



- These are used for patients who basically have a strong and healthy tooth structure even if the tooth has gaps, discolored, crooked, or misshapen. Any of these teeth can be saved if the tooth structure is strong and healthy. Opt for the **Best Veneers for Stained Teeth**.
- Veneers are brittle yet solid so if the tooth that should be fixed does a lot of grinding and biting veneers would not be a fair decision. Choose the [Best Veneers for Tooth Gaps](#) if they are spoiling the appearance of the mouth.

### Crowns:

- When receiving a crown it will embed the entire tooth.
- In order for the crown to implement over the whole tooth, the density of the tooth will require to be lessened by approximately two millimeters or more.
- Using a crown will change the color and shape of the tooth drastically so they are mainly used to repair teeth that are decayed or broken
- They are stronger than dental veneers so they can be utilized on teeth that function the most chewing and grinding

### **The difference in their cost:**

One of the bigger factors influencing costs will be what your insurance covers. Dental veneers are considered strictly cosmetic as they only cover the surface of the tooth and don't provide protection. Crowns, however, can be used for health purposes, sealing and strengthening teeth that have significant damage or decay. You should consult with your insurance company and check to see what is covered as it can be complex. A crown procedure that is purely cosmetic will likely be rejected, so there must be a medical reason for it. If paying out of pocket, dental veneers can be a few hundred dollars cheaper than crowns. The price you pay is usually determined per tooth and if there are any other procedures that need to be performed first.
