They are also handy for everyday tasks like sending emails, applying for jobs, creating budgets, as well as paying bills.

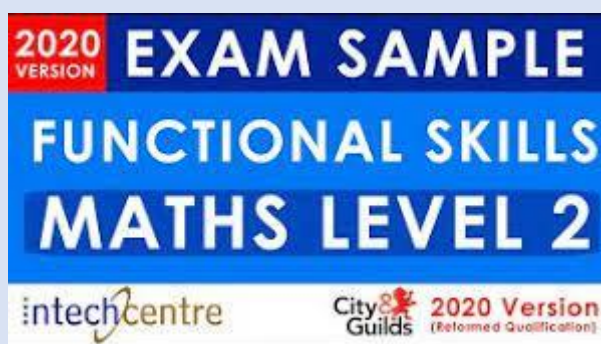
These abilities are often examined at the conclusion of high school as being the part of GCSE exams.
