

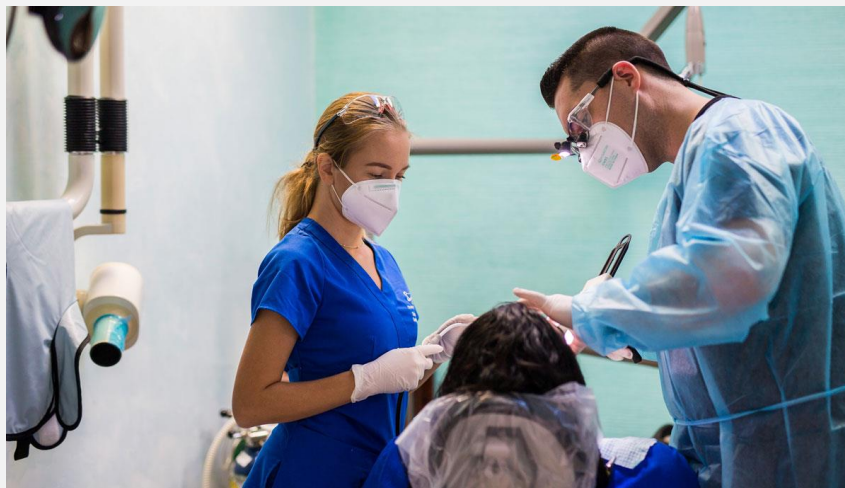
# The Importance of the Process of Root Canal Therapy for Dental Health

## What is a Root Canal?

The inner part of your tooth contains a soft pulp consisting of blood vessels and nerves. If this pulp becomes infected or the tooth is badly decayed, you may experience pain, swelling or sensitivity to hot or cold temperatures. In that condition you need **same day emergency dental**. A root canal procedure, sometimes known as an endodontic procedure, removes that pulp, relieving your symptoms and restoring the tooth.



## What Type of Dentist Performs Root Canals?

A general dentist may perform this procedure, or you may seek treatment with a specialist called an endodontist. Endodontists specialize in tooth pulp disorders and typically handle complicated cases and those where a second dental root canal is needed.

## What is the Procedure for a Root Canal?

First, your dentist numbs the gum around your tooth with a gel. Then, an anesthetic is injected to fully numb your teeth, gums, and tongue in the affected area. The numbing effect could take a few minutes to manifest.

Once your gums and teeth are numbed, the dentist will:

- Place a small rubber shield around the tooth to keep the area clean.
- To reach the pulp of your tooth, create a hole in its crown.
- Remove the pulp, clean the pulp chamber, and shape the root area.
- Place fluid in the canals to remove debris and disinfect the area.
- Fill the canals and seal them.
- Place a root canal crown on the tooth.



## How Much Does a Root Canal Cost?

The cost of this procedure varies according to the severity of your tooth damage, how much pre-treatment you need, and the number of roots in the tooth. The cost also depends on whether your procedure is performed by an endodontist or a general dentist. Some of the part of the insurance plan which is covered in the cost of the procedures. Your dentist will give you a cost estimate after a thorough evaluation.

## What should you expect after the surgery?

After a root canal, the tooth is restored to its normal functionality. Chewing, speaking, and smiling are all made easier because the tooth was not pulled. The best part is that the infection-related toothache will totally go.
