### Floss Often

A majority of American adults don't floss enough. Not flossing may lead to problems in your teeth and implants. This is because food particles tend to deposit around your implants. Because it is hard to reach each and every area of the mouth, bacteria accumulate and cause plaque. To maintain a **bright smile teeth whitening**, you should often floss so that there are no complications.

### Avoid Using Products with Harsh Ingredients

This means you should avoid any products that can be harsh on the implants. For example, some toothpaste and mouthwashes contain harsh or abrasive chemicals that may potentially damage the false

teeth. Products that are more abrasive have a tendency to cause aching and discomfort in the mouth. It is wise to invest in products approved by a [dentist near me for implants](#), and you need to avoid any product with intense flavor.

## Avoid Smoking

Smoking badly affects the process of recovering from a dental implant because it makes the natural body heal slowly. Therefore, it is recommended that patients avoid smoking for some period both before and after dental implant surgery. ## Diet precaution

Being able to eat and drink almost everything you want without having to make significant lifestyle changes is one of the best things about obtaining dental implants. But before you take a sip, let your tea and coffee cool a little. Avoid extremely hard foods, such as raw veggies. Steer clear of sticky candy such as gum and taffy.



## Stop chewing on ice

Apart from hard foods, dental implant patients refrain from chewing on ice. Ice is a much harder object and could hurt your replacement tooth.

## Stay Alertive

It is one of the finest lines of defense against implant loss. Keep in mind some of the common signs of implant failure and seek treatment at the first sign that something might be amiss. The sooner this is treated, the higher the chance you have of saving your implants. Finally, especially see dental care if you notice pain or swelling around your implants or if you sense that your implants have become loose.
