## What are the symptoms of an abscessed tooth?

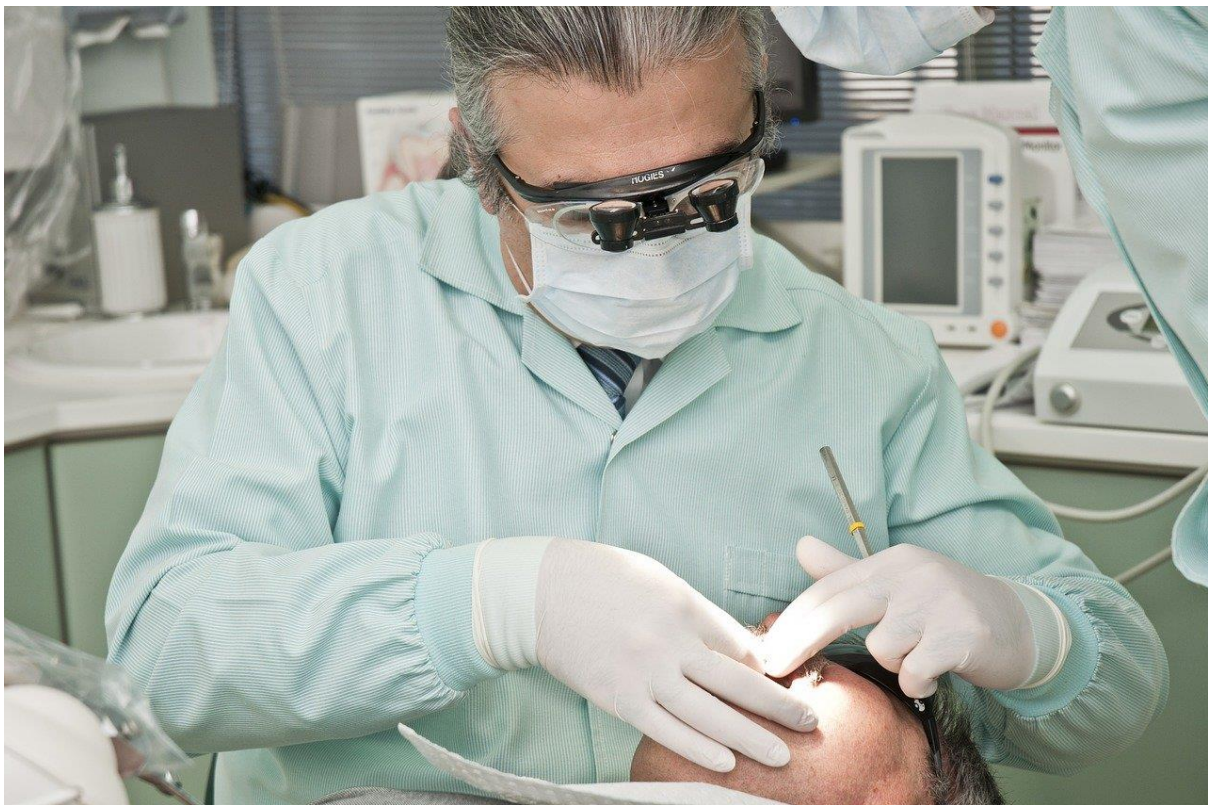
We have mentioned below some symptoms of an abscessed tooth that requires emergency treatment such as:
