

# What Is Dental Bridging?

Do you have missing teeth? You must then visit a [dentist office near me](#) to find a fix for it. People visit an **emergency dentist near me** to not just replace the missing teeth but also to enhance the smile. **Orthodontist near me** state that the best way to fill up for missing teeth is with dental bridges and implants. The dental bridges fill the gaps between the teeth to enhance the smile. The dental bridges are a false tooth that is held in place by the abutment teeth on either side of the gap. However, not many are aware of dental bridges. If you are planning to opt for dental bridges but have no knowledge about it, then this post is meant for you.



## **What are dental bridges?**

The [dental bridge](#) is a false tooth that is used for replacing the missing or decayed or damaged teeth. The dental bridges, also known as pontics, are made of a variety of materials such as gold. The dental bridges are also made of porcelain, and they aesthetically blend in with the natural teeth. A bridge is a fixed dental restoration that is used to replace one or more missing teeth by joining an artificial tooth definitively to the adjacent teeth or dental implants.

## **What are the different types of dental bridges?**

There are four major types of dental bridges which are as follows:

### Traditional dental bridge

According to **periodontist** a conventional tooth bridge consists of a false tooth or teeth that are held in place by dental crowns. They are cemented onto each of the abutment teeth. The traditional bridges are the most popular type of dental bridges, and they are used when there are natural teeth on both sides of the gap created by the missing tooth.

### Cantilever dental bridge

The cantilever dental bridges are similar to the traditional bridges. These pontics in a cantilever dental bridge are held in place with a dental crown. They are cemented on only one of the abutment tooth.

### Maryland dental bridge

As per the [emergency dentist](#), the Maryland dental bridges require two abutment teeth. They are placed on each side of the gap. These types of dental bridges use dental crowns on the abutment teeth. The Maryland bridges use a framework of either metal or porcelain that are bonded onto the backs of the abutment teeth.



### Implant-supported dental bridge

These types of dental bridges, according to an orthodontist near me, make use of dental implants as opposed to crowns or frameworks. In these types of dental bridges, one implant is surgically placed over the missing tooth in a manner that they hold the bridge in place. For cases in which one implant placement isn't possible therein, the bridges have a pontic suspended between two implants supported crowns. The implant-supported bridges require two surgeries which are as follows:

The first surgery which embeds the implants in the jawbone In the second surgery, the bridge is placed.

### What is the costing of the dental bridges?

The traditional bridges cost between \$2000-\$5000. Customized bridges as per **dental clinic near me** cost between \$5000-\$15000.
