

# Wisdom Teeth Removal: What You Need To Know?

The last set of teeth to erupt in the mouth which normally appears to happen around the age of 15 to 25 is known as the wisdom teeth. Wisdom teeth are the third set of Molars. But this set of teeth has faced a lot of controversy and a huge debate on whether teeth should be removed or not. These teeth are fine to stay in their place if they don't cause you any harm or pain, but if they cause any harm or pain due to [wisdom tooth infection](#) or if you have impacted wisdom teeth, they should be removed immediately. This does not mean that while the eruption process of the teeth is taking place you will not feel any **wisdom tooth pain**. It is a fact that you will experience pain while the tooth is in its eruption process.



You can get rid of the wisdom teeth by pulling them out or by the **wisdom teeth removal** process. You can also cut down the wisdom teeth but for doing that you will need to consult an experienced and qualified surgeon. First of all, you need to consult an oral center or visit your family dentist.

## **Wisdom Tooth Extraction Procedure:**

Your **emergency dentist** or oral surgeon will ask you to take a few x-rays of your teeth to know exactly how badly your teeth are affected. After studying all the reports your dentist at the [dental clinic near me](#) will provide you with options that you can choose to have wisdom teeth removal near me or cut down your wisdom teeth. To provide you with all the available options the dentist first needs to know what is the condition of your wisdom teeth.

If you need to extract or cut down your wisdom teeth, you have two options to reduce your pain. First of all, you can use local anesthesia or else go for IV sedation. IV sedation is a

process of using recommended drugs to ease your pain and anxiety and it is used to generally facilitate the diagnostic procedure of medical procedure. Drugs like propofol or ketamine can be used for IV sedation. The beauty of IV sedation is that you will not be aware of anything that is happening to you while that dentist will pull out your wisdom teeth. Whereas while using local anesthesia, you will be able to hear cracking and popping involved, which can make you uncomfortable. You will be numb if anesthesia is used on you to carry out the dental procedure.



Depending on the formation size and shape of the wisdom teeth the whole removal procedure of your wisdom teeth can greatly vary from easy to difficult. If you have extremely bad luck the root tip of your teeth can manage to grab them around the nearby bone, then the procedure can be painful and time-consuming. You will experience normal to no swelling after the tooth extraction process has been completed. Do not forget to take the painkiller medicine prescribed by your dentist. If you choose to use IV sedation to avoid the pain, then you will need someone to accompany you for the next 24 hours as you will not be able to drive home alone.

### **After The Removal:**

Your emergency dentist will provide all the necessary information to you for taking care of your mouth. After the extraction procedure is completed you will have to take intense care of the amount and avoid any hard food. Hard food means anything that can hurt your mouth as your wisdom teeth are freshly removed. You can consume juices if you want for the next 48 hours to keep you healthy and avoid starvation. After the removal of your wisdom teeth, you will experience a great improvement in your smile.
