THE SCHOOL YEAR IN FRANCE

The school year in France typically begins in early September and concludes in early July. Students usually return to school on the first Monday of September. The academic year is divided into three terms : the first term runs from early September to mid December, the second term from early January to mid April, and the third term from late April to early July.

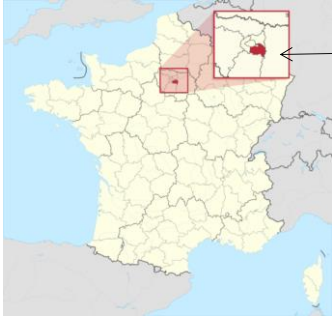
Throughout the school year, there are several holidays. **The Toussaint break** lasts about two weeks at the end of October to early November, followed by a two-week **Christmas break** of about two weeks in April. Finally, **Summer vacation** lasts approximately two months, from early July to early September.

In addition to regular classes, internships are an essential part of the educational experience, especially for vocational school students. These internships typically occur during the second term and can last from a few days to several weeks, providing valuable real-work experience and helping students to prepare for their future careers.

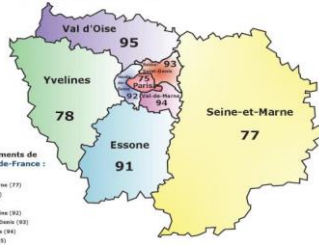

We live and study in Ile de France. Most of us live in Val de Marne (94), Seine St Denis (93) or Seine et Marne (77).

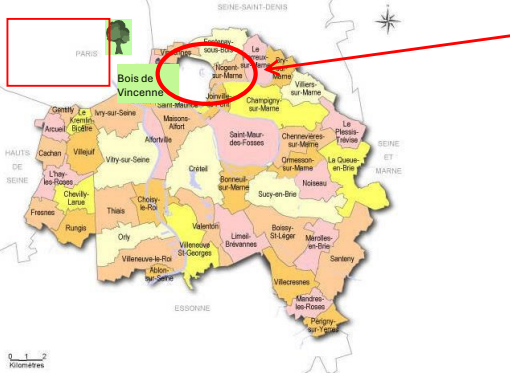


La région Île-de-France et ses départements
