## **Different types of cosmetic dentistry treatments**

Some of the **cosmetic dentistry near me** dental treatments are mentioned below:

**1. Dentures:** A prosthetic device is known as a denture and it is also known as a false tooth. You can easily take **dentures near me** out whenever you want or put them back, unlike your original teeth. **Partial dentures** are one of the types of dentures.



**2. Bleaching:** This is also known by the name teeth whitening. You can opt for this procedure, to make your teeth look whiter. The stains and discoloration from teeth are removed with the help of the bleaching process. Two types of teeth whitening are available namely laser tooth whitening and a professional home whitening kit. Depending on the condition of the teeth to be whitened, the dentist might call you for two or more visits for teeth whitening in the office.

**3. Bonding:** If you have broken, chipped, discolored, or decayed teeth then it's time to repair and reset them. A composite [teeth bonding](#) procedure is beneficial to correct their appearance. In addition, it can also prove to be beneficial in closing the space's teeth. It can last for several years if bonding is performed under the guidance of an expert dentist.

**4. Dental crowns:** For treating decayed, broken, poorly shaped, or chipped teeth these are best suitable. Crowns also refer to as **tooth caps** and can be made as per your tooth size. Acrylic or porcelain is generally used to make the **tooth crown**. Covering the spaces between the teeth, they are also proving to be beneficial.

**5. Veneers:** For correcting and repairing cracks or chips, dental veneers are best suitable. If you have gaps between the teeth then also they can be prescribed by your dentist. In the front of the teeth, the **veneer teeth** are placed.

**6. Tooth reshaping:** It is best for correcting crooked teeth, uneven teeth, chipped, irregular teeth. Tooth reshaping is best to alter the length, shape, or position of your teeth.

**7. Implants:** To replace the missing teeth the dentist makes use of **dental implants**. It is a metal device made up of titanium.
