When is it essential to remove wisdom teeth?

How to identify if you need a wisdom teeth extraction?

We have mentioned some signs that show you might need to get a **wisdom teeth removal soon, such as:**

- Experiencing pain
- Infection in the gum tissue
- Formation of cysts
- Tumors
- Injury to adjacent teeth.
- Gum disease.
- Extreme tooth decay

What happens if you don't get wisdom teeth pulled?

Although not all patients seek tooth extraction, which may lead to further complications, several more people with the disease have relatively small jaws, which do not enable proper third molar development. Studies have shown that overcrowding can sometimes occur after wisdom tooth extraction, which generates shifting of teeth or overlapping.

How long is wisdom teeth surgery?

Generally, wisdom tooth extraction procedures take about 45 minutes. Even though individuals are under anesthesia, the tooth extraction will be painless. The patient

can choose between general anesthesia, oral sedation, and intravenous sedation. Alternatively, your doctor would then advise you on the best alternative for your procedure.

What are the things you should do after wisdom tooth extraction?

We have mentioned some advice you should follow for a fast and better recovery from wisdom teeth extraction.

- Applying an ice pack to your face is highly recommended to reduce swelling.
- To restore the power of the jaw, exercising of mouth is important
- Soft foods, such as pasta, rice, or soup, are highly recommended as a diet
- Drink a lot of water for hydration
- Be careful while brushing as it may open the blood clot in the affected area.
- To get relief from pain or swelling, take the medicines prescribed by your dental specialist.

What makes a wisdom tooth impacted?

Wisdom teeth become impacted when your jaw doesn't have room to adjust or help your wisdom tooth grow. The wisdom tooth can also become affected if they erupt in the wrong structure.
