## **What Are Dental Implants?**

The implants are devices that are used to replace the roots of the missing teeth. They are used to support crowns, bridges, or dentures. The implants are surgically placed in the jawbone. Most of the time, the implants feel more natural and secure than other methods of replacing missing teeth such as dentures. **Dental Implants Dentist** states that the implants improve the aesthetics of the teeth and their functionality.

## What are the different types of dental implants?

There are several types of implants available in the market. Here is a list of the primary types of dental implants.

### 1. Endosteal Implants

Endosteal implants are the most common type of dental implants. They are most suited for patients who desire to have a good and healthy jawbone. The **Dental Implants Houston** state that the endosteal implants are placeholder posts that are shaped like screws. They are placed in the jaw where the false teeth would be fitted. Once the procedure is done, then it takes time to heal. The implants take time to fuse and create a stronghold. Once its healed, then the false teeth are placed on it.



### 2. Subperiosteal Implants

Subperiosteal [Dental Implants Houston Tx](#) is an alternative to the endosteal implants. These implants are fixed into the jawbone and rest on top of the bone but are still under the gums. The metal frame is placed under the gum with a post attached to it. The gums, when healing, hold the structure in place. The false teeth are secured to the poles that come from the gum.

### 3. Zygomatic Implants

These are the least common types of dental implants. They involve a complicated procedure and are used when there is not enough space in the jawbone for the endosteal implant. These implants are placed in the patient's cheekbone rather than on the jaw.
