

What is a Dental Bridge?

A pontic is an artificial tooth used in dental bridges to secure the abutment teeth on either side of the gap. Pontics are often made of porcelain to blend in with your natural teeth. But they can also be made of other materials, like gold.

What are the types of dental bridges?

Here are some types of dental bridges:

- Traditional
- Implant-supported
- Standard dental bridge

A typical dental bridge consists of crowns bonded to each abutment tooth, which hold the dental crown or teeth in place. The primary type of dental bridge is a conventional bridge, which can be used when you still have healthy and hygienic teeth on either side of the gap left by your lost tooth.

Cantilever dental bridges are similar to conventional bridges in that only one abutment tooth serves as the anchor for the pontic, which is secured in place by a dental crown, in favor of a cantilever bridge, to fill the space left by a missing tooth, you only need one natural tooth.

Dental bridges for teeth

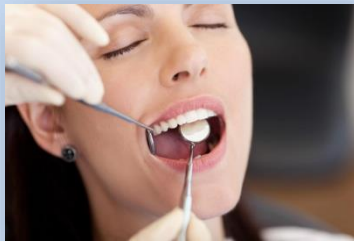
Dental bridges need two healthy abutment teeth—one on either side of the gap—just like a conventional bridge. In contrast, a dental bridge is made of metal or porcelain framework bonded onto the backs of the abutment teeth. A traditional bridge puts dental crowns on the abutment teeth.

Like a standard bridge, a dental bridge is only an option if there is a natural tooth on either side of the gap left by the lost tooth or teeth.

The dental bridge supported by implants

As the name suggests, dental implants support bridges rather than frameworks or crowns. An implant is often surgically implanted for every lost tooth, and this implant holds the bridge in place. Suppose it is impossible to place one implant for each lost tooth. In that case, the bridge may consist of a pontic hanging between two implant-supported crowns. An implant-supported bridge often needs two procedures and is said to be the most robust and stable system:

- Embedding the implants into the jawbone
- Another procedure to implant the bridge
- The process may not be finished for several months.



What is the price of a dental bridge?

Numerous factors can impact the cost, including:

- Materials used, such as composite resin, zirconia, or metal alloy covered in resin
- The number of teeth required to fill the gap
- Extra dental procedures for problems like gum disease

Implants versus dental bridges

Many dental policies cover bridges, and many now also cover implants. Depending on how much is taken care of, the [Cosmetic Dental Bridge](#) might need to be updated every seven to fifteen years, whereas implants are considered a permanent solution. Some factors can reduce the life of all bridges, including implants and dental hygiene.
