Your dentist places endosteal implants into your jawbone and also needs the aforementioned two-stage treatment option. They will suggest these types of dental implants in place of bridges and dentures.

Single-Stage Dental Implants

In this type of dental implant, you need a long implant in your jaw and gums so that your top most layer exposes. As a result, it takes several months of healing time for the placement of abutment and restoration of implants without having a surgical cut on your dental implant again.
