Dental Bonding

Suppose your teeth are chipped, cracked, stained, or have missing gaps. In that case, **Dental Office Houston** will recommend a dental bonding to fix the issue cosmetically. They will apply some adhesive and composite resin that exactly matches your teeth' color and reshapes your smile back.

Crowns

Crown is often a restorative and cosmetic procedure covering your tooth above the gumline. They are also used after a root canal treatment because damaged teeth are too fractured for a filling, and teeth are badly chipped or misshapen.



Bridges

Bridges are prosthetic devices designed to replace entire teeth with an artificially one called a pontic. They are called bridges because they fill the gap between your teeth, attach your teeth on either side and prevent drifting either side of the missing gap.

Dentures for arch replacement benefits

Dentures are oral appliances made of a gum-colored, acrylic base and artificial teeth, also they may be fabricated from porcelain or resin teeth material matched to any existing teeth or ideal color choice. There are partial in this; if you have some teeth missing, you can consider partial ones, or complete dentures mean they can replace your whole teeth structure in both the upper and lower arc of your mouth.
