

# What is a dental bridge?

A dental bridge can refill the gap with one or more artificial teeth if you have a missing tooth, including the front teeth. A [dental bridge](#) can help restore your teeth' natural look and function by filling the gap where the tooth is missing. It acts like a bridge between your teeth and fills the vacant space of the tooth.

A dental bridge helps restore your smile and chewing ability, protects your other teeth to stay in their position, and improves your speech and pronunciation.



Dental bridges can prevail for up to 10 years if you maintain good oral hygiene and a regular check-up.

Pontics (a false tooth) is made from various materials such as gold. Generally, they are made from porcelain to blend in with your natural teeth aesthetically.

There are four types of dental bridges:

1. Traditional
2. Cantilever
3. Maryland
4. Implant-supported

## What is the cost of a dental bridge?

Many variables can affect the price, including:

1. The Material, your dentist uses, such as zirconia, composite resin, or metal alloy covered in resin for the placement.
2. The number of teeth you need to fill the gap.
3. Other dental issues, like gum disease treatment.

The costs also count on the type of bridge that you choose:

1. Traditional or cantilever bridges cost \$2,000 – \$5,000 for one pontic( false tooth) and a crown for each abutment tooth.
2. Maryland bridges typically cost \$1,500 – \$2,500 for one pontic with the framework, or wings, attached to the abutment teeth.
3. An implant-supported bridge costs \$5,000 – \$15,000 for a bridge with two dental implants spanning three or four teeth.

Tooth bonding is a process in which the dentist applies a tooth-colored composite resin to the required tooth to repair the damaged tooth.
