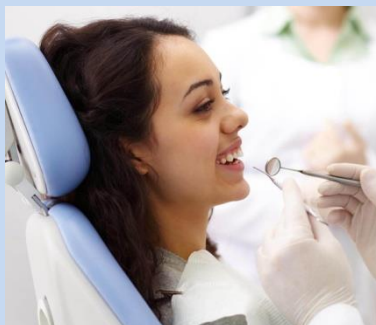


# What Are The Four Alternatives to Veneers?

Before a cosmetic dental procedure, consider whether you want whiter teeth or a straighter smile. However, [veneers](#) can correct several dental issues. But there are more options, such as:

## Crowns-

**Tooth crowns** are either made of metal, porcelain, or ceramic. They are more durable than veneers but still can chip and break. Crowns are mainly used to replace a decayed tooth or if you have a damaged tooth. Therefore, crowns are strong, and they can be made color match your teeth. They help restore a highly damaged tooth that you can't chew properly. The cost of a crown may vary depending on how many you need for your teeth, and the price can increase if you do not have insurance.



## Bonding

Bonding is recommended as a quick fix for discolored or chipped teeth, and it covers the tooth with a layer of a material called composite resin. However, less of your natural tooth is removed in preparation for the bonding, unlike veneers and crowns. As the dentist places the material on your teeth, your dentist will shape the material to fit the tooth and cover it with a UV light. The bonding cost is much less than veneers but is not as stain-resistant as veneers.

Grinding teeth habit can damage the bonding material that your dentist may advise you for a mouth guard. Taking care of your teeth by avoiding acidic or sugary foods after bonding can impair adhesion.

## Teeth Whitening

If you are going for a teeth whitening treatment, your dentist will first examine your tooth for any decay or other dental problems. A teeth whitening treatment can brighten your severely stained teeth.

Your dentist will use a bleaching agent to smoothen the teeth, remove them, and reapply them. Your dentists will employ a highly concentrated whitening gel and a high-intensity laser light to whiten your teeth within two hours with safety, although [veneers cost](#) less.

## Braces/Invisalign

If you have severely misaligned teeth or jaw, you may have to consider braces or Invisalign, but veneers are perfect for gaps between teeth and slightly crooked or misshapen teeth. Braces can be a good option as they are less noticeable, and Invisalign is entirely invisible if compared to braces. They both are costly and take months to give the results.



## What Are Snap On Veneers?

**Snap-on veneers** are easily removable dental appliances that are made from resin material.

They are custom-made to fit over your natural teeth and can hide discoloration, misalignment, or any other dental issues in your teeth.

Snap-on veneers are like regular, permanently-bonded veneers.

Snap veneers are an ideal choice for situations where you want a quick and easy way to make your smile appearance beautiful and at a reasonable price. Just "snap" them over your teeth to put them on.

Veneers fix many dental issues but can be pricey and unsuitable for every situation.
