How much time does it take aligners to straighten teeth?

Straightening teeth depends on the condition of your teeth needing to be moved, rotated, or aligned properly. It will take more time to align if your teeth are more crooked or if there is space between them. Then it usually takes 10 to 24 months to align appropriately. But if you had braces as a child, it will take up to 10 weeks to straighten teeth with invisible braces.

2. Appearance:

Treatment cases in clear braces:

2. Crowded teeth
Crowded teeth are when there is no space for teeth, and they overlap. They are rotated or overlapped.
3. Overbite teeth
Some teeth do not align when they meet, and sometimes they protrude outwards.
4. Crossbite teeth
The misalignment arch of the upper and lower teeth is called cross bite teeth.
5. Gaps between teeth
Spacing or gaps between the teeth is when there is space between your teeth. Using braces, you can minimize the distance.
6. Deep bite
When your upper teeth overlap the lower front teeth. In this case, when a person smiles, the lower teeth are not visible.
7. Underbite
It is a condition when the lower teeth are on top of the upper front teeth.

8. Open bite

When your back upper and lower teeth combine, the front teeth of the upper and lower do not touch because of the gap between the front upper teeth and lower teeth.
