## What is Teeth Bonding And How It works?

Teeth bonding is a process where the dentists put a tooth-colored composite gum to one or more teeth to improve a damaged area of your teeth. It is a statement of composite resin to

the covering of the tooth to repair it. It's an easy, affordable cosmetic dental method that generally takes one single visit for the successful completion of the process.

Starting with the process, the dentist applies a color guide to select the resin color tone as per your natural color teeth. The **Best Dentist In Houston** cleans the coverings of the teeth and then puts a liquid solution that provides the bonding agent to attach to the teeth.



Your dental specialist utilizes the composite tar over the liquid, forms, or shapes the tooth, then, at that point solidifies the texture with bright.

If it is important, then the dentists would give the shape to your teeth after the resin hardens.

### How to prepare for teeth bonding?

It does not require any special preparation. All you need to do is consult the best dentist if you want to go for the teeth bonding procedure. Also, it will not be going to work if there is any severe damage or decay. Then you may need a veneer or crown instead.

## Risks of Teeth Bonding

## What is the cost of teeth bonding?

However, the normal cost ranges between \$300 to \$600 per tooth. And make sure that you are going to replace the bonding every 5 to 10 years.

## How to care for bonded teeth?

The doctor suggests that if you want that bonded teeth to last for a longer time then you should need to take care of them. Self-care tips include:

- Clean your teeth at least twice a day and flossing daily
- avoiding hard food and candy
- not biting your nails
- After the procedure, start Withdrawing coffee, tea, and tobacco for the first two days to avoid stains
- scheduling regular dental cleanings every six months
