Step 1: Consultation

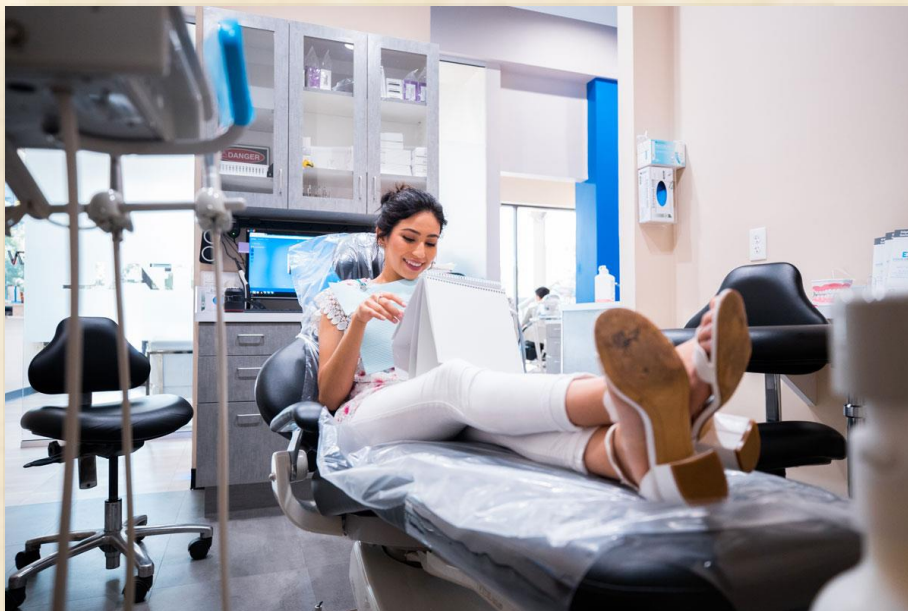
