## Permanent Tooth Replacement Options

### Dental Implants

Dental implants are the **Best Teeth Replacement** for the original tooth because they replace the roots of missing natural teeth and the final restoration of the look and feel of a natural tooth. They can be placed in the jawbones to support bridges, crowns, or complete dentures and are the best like-a-like solution for missing teeth.

### The Process.

The dentist performs a thorough assessment of your teeth. This includes reviewing your history and digital scanning, including X-rays. They will check for any infection and the amount of bone structure.

The surgery is conducted in several stages. First, your dentist removes the damaged tooth and its remnants. They will do bone grafting to place dental appliances if there is not enough bone structure.

After the treatment site heals, your dentist moves forward because the dental implant needs time to integrate with the surrounding bone before the abutment can be attached to the implant.

The abutment allows the final crown to be sure on the dental implant. In this way, your dentist performs the surgery and makes pseudo teeth like natural teeth. This procedure takes one year at least and may vary depending on your healing process and the complexity of the treatment.

## All-on-Four Implant-Supported Dentures

All-on-Four Implant-Supported Dentures are the best tooth replacement options that allow complete dentures to be placed for dental implants. It's the best for patients with complete tooth loss or bone loss; moreover, it prevents them from getting multiple **Dental Implants Houston Midtown**.

### The Process.

Two implants are placed near the front portion to replace the canine teeth. Additionally, teeth are placed further back for better support to the appliance.

These dental implants are often angled to maximize bone support. The treatment helps you allow a complete arch of 12-14 teeth to secure only four teeth.



Temporary dentures are usually placed before the implant surgery to give functionality to the patients while the dental implant heals. This takes 6-7 months to heal completely; after this, your dentist places the restoration, which may be a screw-retained denture, permanent bridgework, or screw-retained dentures.

## Removable Partial Denture

Removal partial dentures are the best replacement for one or more missing teeth in the arch. Most partial dentures are made of acrylic bas, which may or may not be removable with the metal substructure. They may also have clasps that fit around your left one teeth to secure the partial dentures in place while talking, eating, or laughing.
