## Basic Kinds Of Dental Failure

- Infection. Bad-fitting fixtures can lead to an infection that requires the removal of the screw. The inappropriate technique or substandard fixtures are common particularly among dentists who do not have enough training or experience.
- Loose implants. This can be caused by substandard fixtures, or if the dental implant is placed on a [Dental Bone Graft](#) structure that is not solid enough.
- Nerve impairment. When improper techniques are used, a badly performed **dental** implant procedure can lead to pain, numbness, and persistent tingling sensation.

There are several reasons for a dental implant to fail. Perhaps the leading cause is when both the Dental Implant Dentist and patient try to settle for cheaper solutions, failing to acknowledge the fact that some implants cost more than others for a particular reason.

Below are some of the most common reasons for dental implant failure:

- Inadequate diagnostic phase. Before getting a dental implant, the patient has to go through a 3D panoramic x-ray. However, some dentists settle for the 2D shortcut.
- Insufficient patient information. There are medical conditions that can affect the outcome of a dental implant procedure, and has to be considered by the dentist before any treatment is started. A thorough diagnosis and interview have to be done to avoid complications later.



- Substandard implant fixtures. Although there are many manufacturers of dental implant fixtures, only a few are consistent with their research programs. Research is expensive and yields to expensive dental implant procedures, but the quality is assured.
- Incorrect implant placement. This goes hand-in-hand with inadequate diagnosis, as this is the stage where the placement of the implant is determined and the type to use. Another cause is the lack of communication between the surgeon and Dental Implant Specialist on who will replace the implant.

Most importantly, look for an experienced surgeon that you can trust, particularly someone who has had extensive training and experience with implants. Ask for recommendations from a friend or ask former patients for their feedback.
