These teeth are fabricated in our on-site lab before we start the procedure. You can put in the temporary teeth once they set the implants in their position.

We begin the process of creating permanent teeth three months later. The final fixed teeth for the whole mouth are either constructed of zirconia or a titanium bar encased in acrylic. Since every full mouth condition is distinct, it relies on your particular circumstances. No matter what, a restoration made to endure will give you a beautiful smile.
