

# What is an All-on-4 Dental Implant Treatment?

The All-on-4 is an advancement of dental Implant that proceeds a new set of teeth either on upper or lower jaws in a single visit.

**All on 4 implants** are a special oral appliance that provides patients with a whole set of teeth using 4 implants per arch. According to reliable studies, **all on 4 dental implants** show a 98% success rate. This placement of All-on-4 takes approximately 2.5 hours per arch. Moreover, All-on-4 allows shorter treatment time and less discomfort and is more economical.

The All-on-4 dental plant treatment utilizes maximum availability of bone for immediate function with tilting posterior implants.



## All-on-4 in a single visit

- Tooth extraction (if needed)
- Dental Implant after placement
- Fabricate and Fit Prosthetics on the Implant

With the **all on 4 dental implants Houston**, your dentist extracts teeth and places the implant post during the surgical visit. Then a fixed acrylic bridge is fabricated 1 to 2 days after the surgery. The timeline for All-on-4 might complete within one dental visit. However, the patient may select the acrylic or porcelain bridge later.

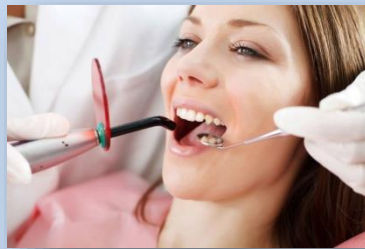
## What are the pros of All-on-4 dental implants?

- All-on-4 requires the very least period of treatment time.
- Easy to replace poor prognosis with new functional teeth

- Immediate results
- All-on-4 treatment suits all types of bone density except for very severe resorption issue

### Treatment

- Unlike other dental procedure, your dentist diagnoses and plan all-on-4 treatment if you are eligible.
- Make a surgical template before dental implant treatment.
- If your dentist finds teeth extraction is needed before placing a dental implant
- Finally, after the placement, the dentist places a prosthetics dental implant, including re-adjustment and re-checks needed.



### What are the risk factors associated with All-on-4 dental implants?

- Primarily to achieve stability.
- There is no function abnormality.
- Fix speech issue
- Difficult to adapt bridge thickness
- High caries index.

### Before the Procedure

In [All-On-4 Dental Implants](#), you don't need bone grafting; sometimes, it may be required depending on bone density. Also, no one has the same mouth, so your dentist needs to diagnose your mouth condition with dental scanning and X-rays.

### During the Procedure

Your dentist uses a local anesthetic to numb your jawbone, and then they will place an implant into the jawbone. Then attaches a provisional prosthesis to the Implant to provide healing time. Once your Implant

has healed, your dentist recommends a permanent solution such as dental bridges or removable dentures that will be placed over the Implant.

### **After the Procedure**

In the first few months after the procedure, your mouth heals, and bone shapes change and adapt according to new fixtures. The patient should limit hard or chewy food and lessen the exercise during this time.

### **Possible discomfort**

You should expect some discomfort and swell immediately after the treatment. However, in most patients, pain and swelling subside after a week.
