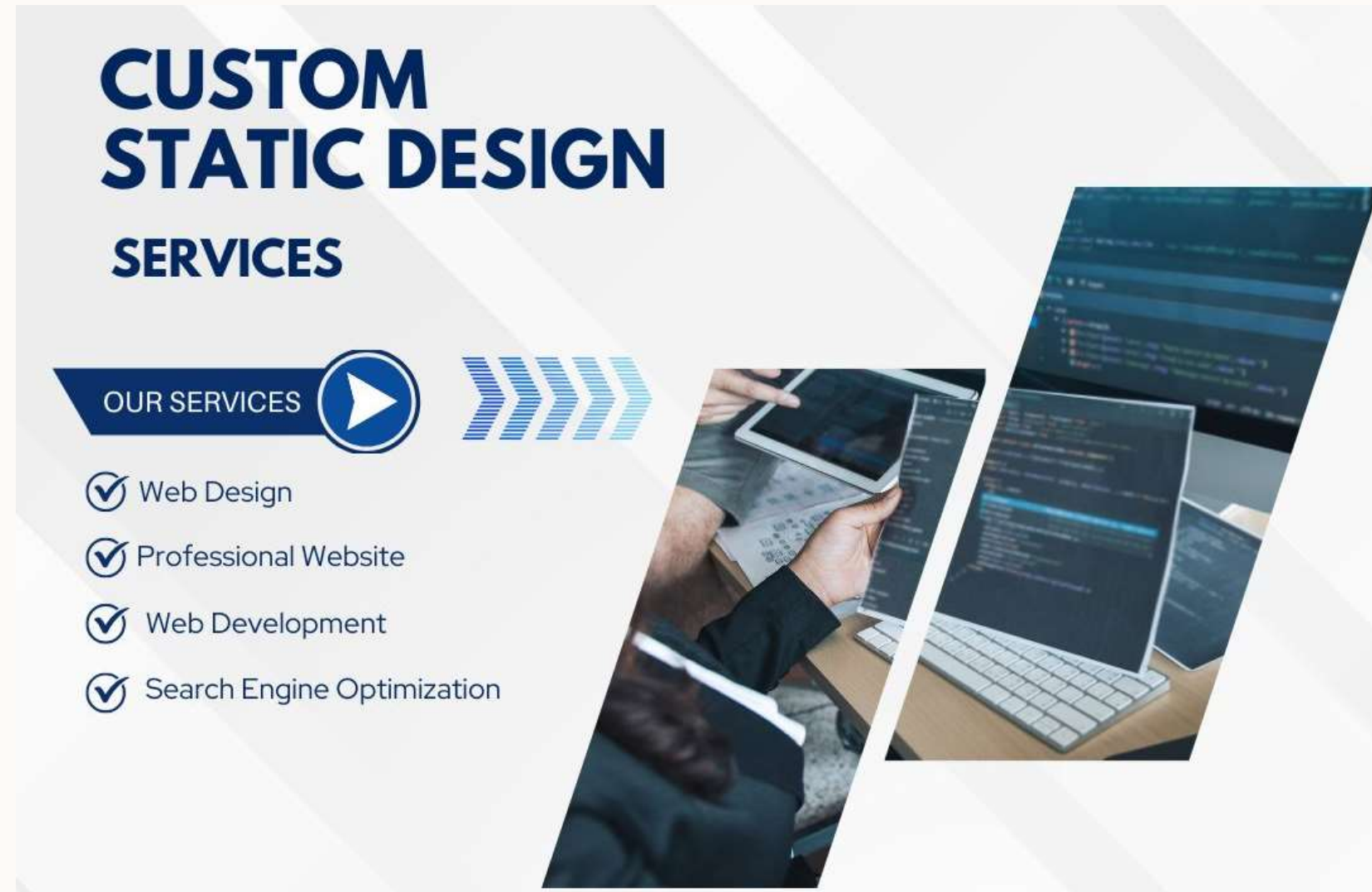

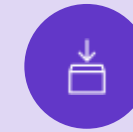

Decision Logic: Choose static websites when budget is limited and content rarely changes (under 4 annual updates). Select CMS platforms when you need self-service updates and plan growth over 2+ years. Invest in ecommerce when sales conversion is your primary goal and you're ready to manage inventory, payments, and fulfillment.

Best Practices for Australian Website Design

1

WCAG Compliance

Ensure accessibility standards meet Australian Disability Discrimination Act requirements. Include alt text for images, keyboard navigation, screen reader compatibility, and color contrast ratios to meet WCAG 2.1 Level AA standards—mandatory for government websites and increasingly expected by private sector users

2

Local Payment Integration

Support Australian payment methods: credit cards, Afterpay, Zip, and local bank transfers. Integrate with Australian payment gateways ensuring secure transactions and compliance with Privacy Act requirements for handling customer data

3

Mobile-First Priority

Design primarily for mobile devices first—Australian users increasingly access sites via smartphone. Employ responsive frameworks ensuring consistent experiences from 4" screens to desktop monitors, critical for users in regional areas relying solely on mobile networks

4

Australian UX Patterns

Adopt local conventions: Australian English spelling, timezone-aware scheduling, Australian currency symbols (\$AUD), and region-specific forms (Australian address formats, state abbreviations). Test navigation patterns with local users to ensure intuitive flows

5

Performance Optimization

Achieve under-3-second load times using CDN hosting within Australia (AWS Sydney region), image compression, lazy loading, and code minification. Critical for users on mobile networks or with limited broadband in rural and remote areas
