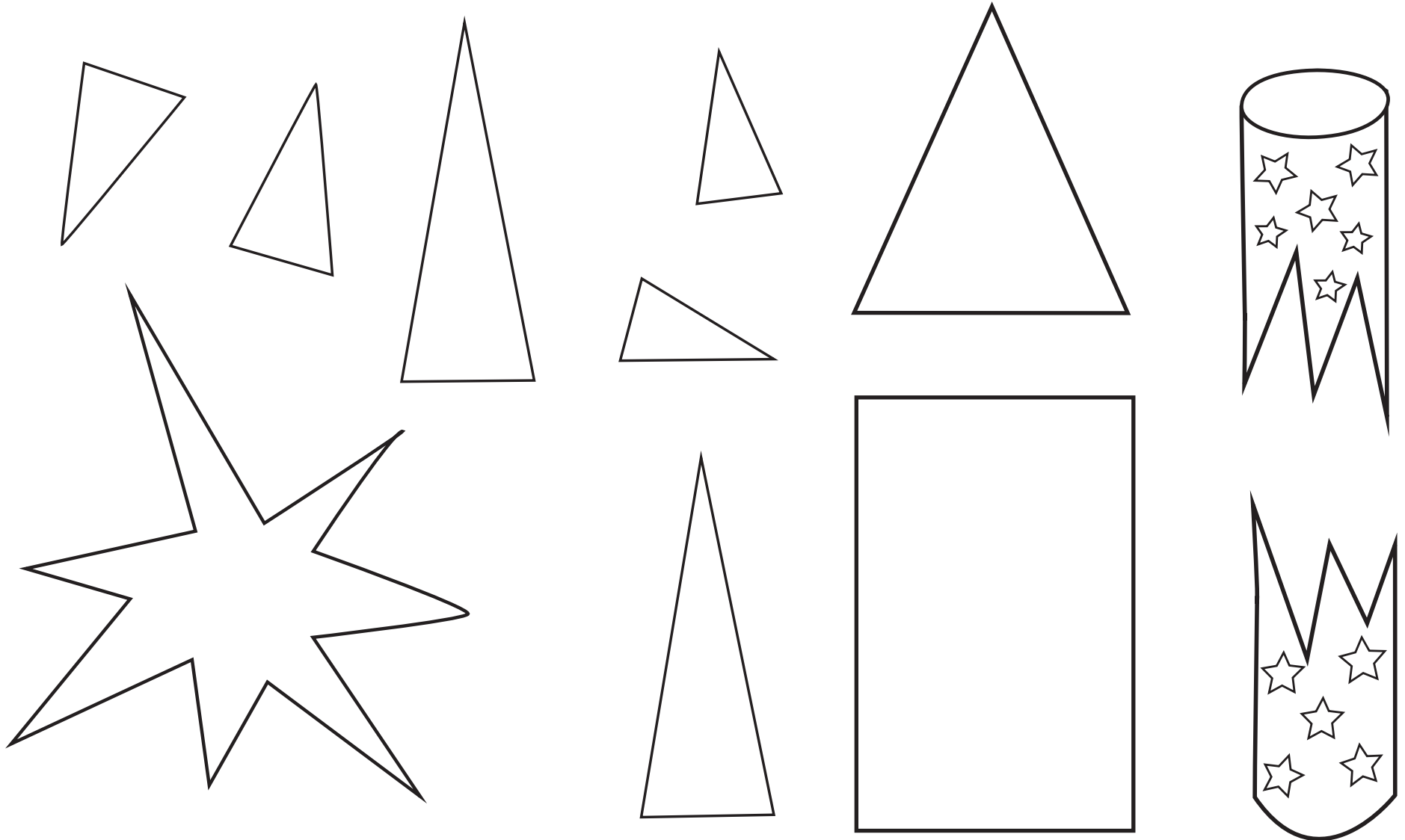




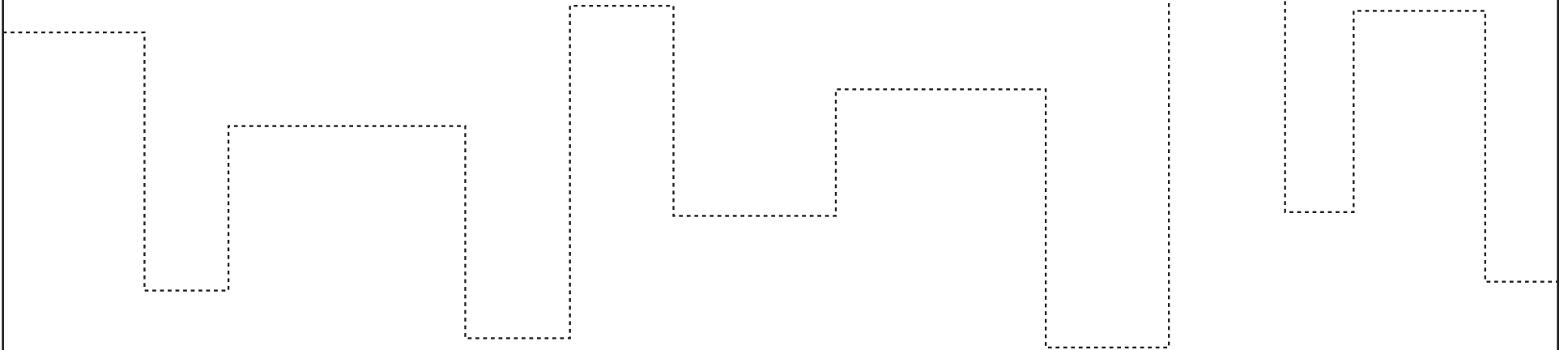
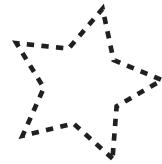
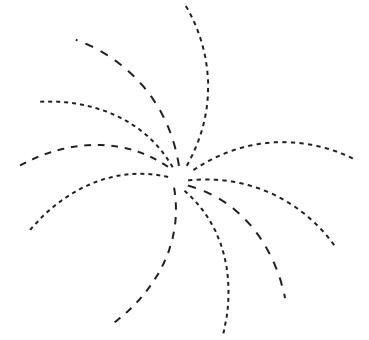
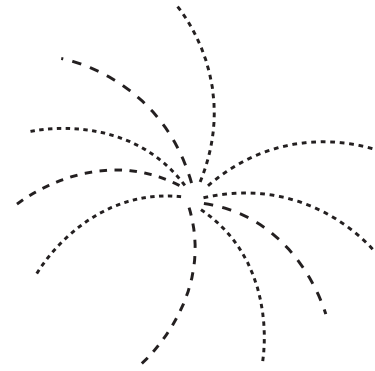
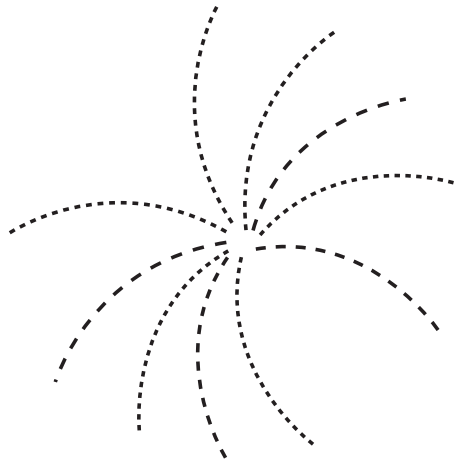
# Design your own Fireworks

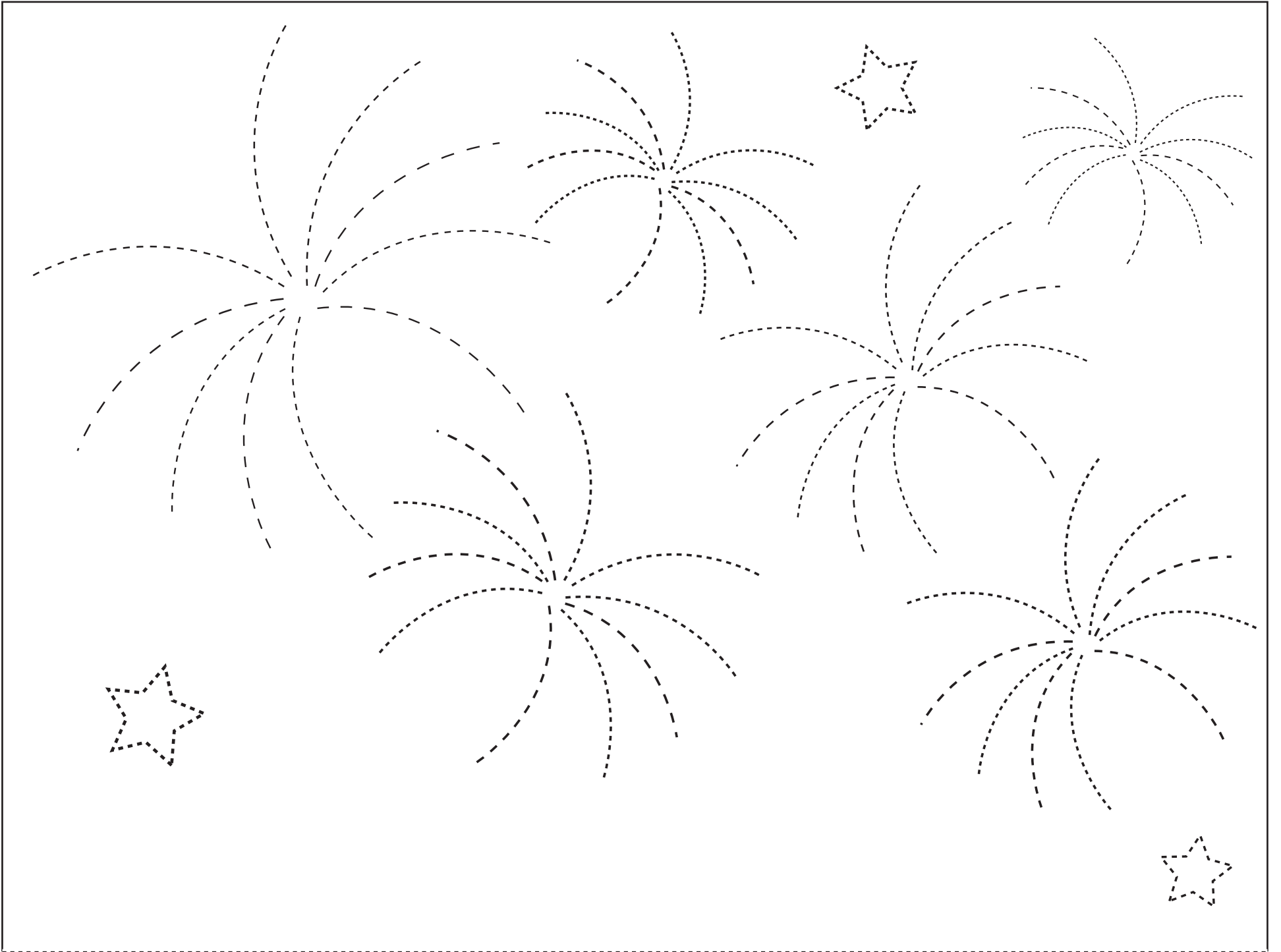
