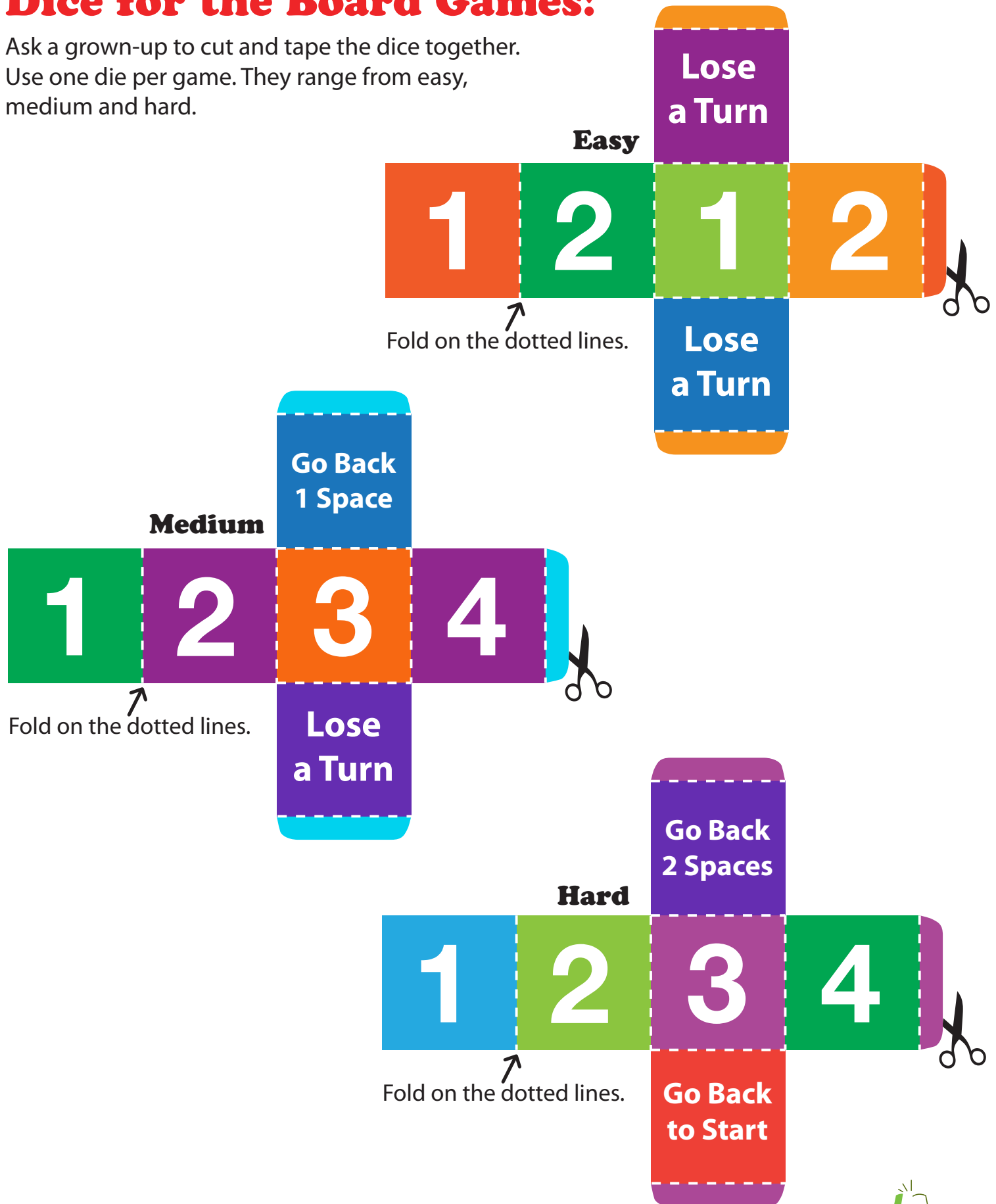


Lollipop Trail
