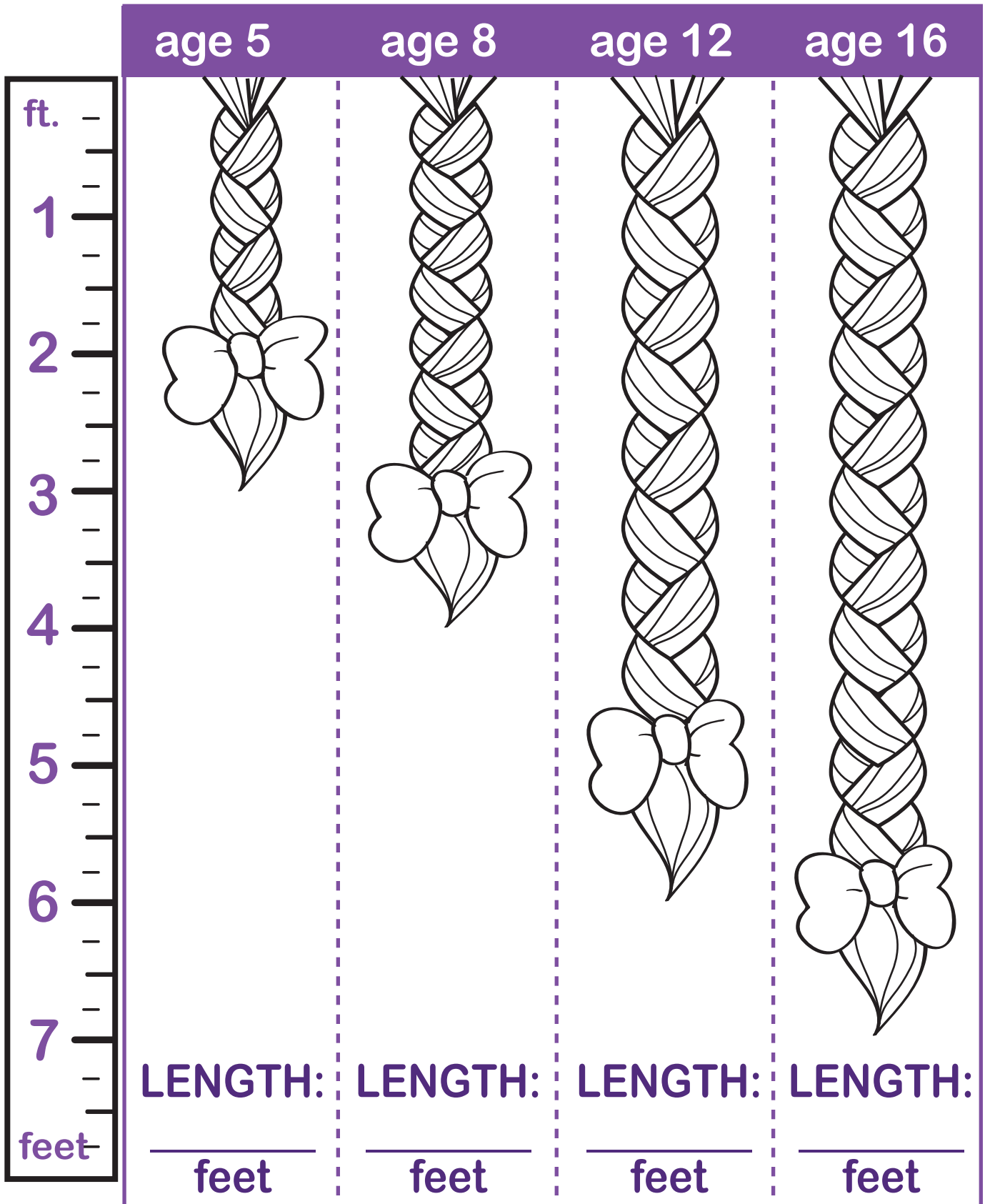


Pretty Princess Fairy

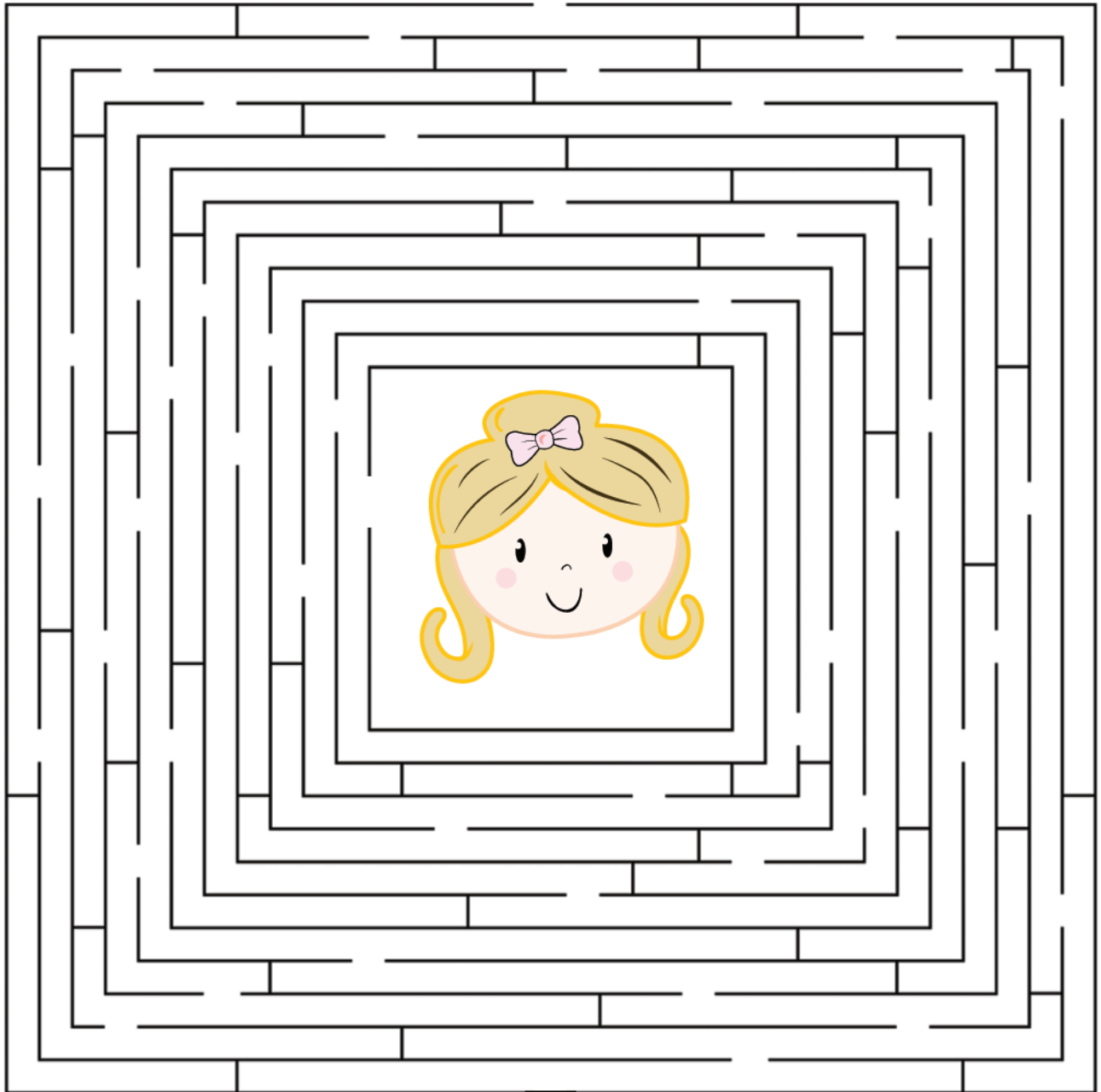


Castle Maze

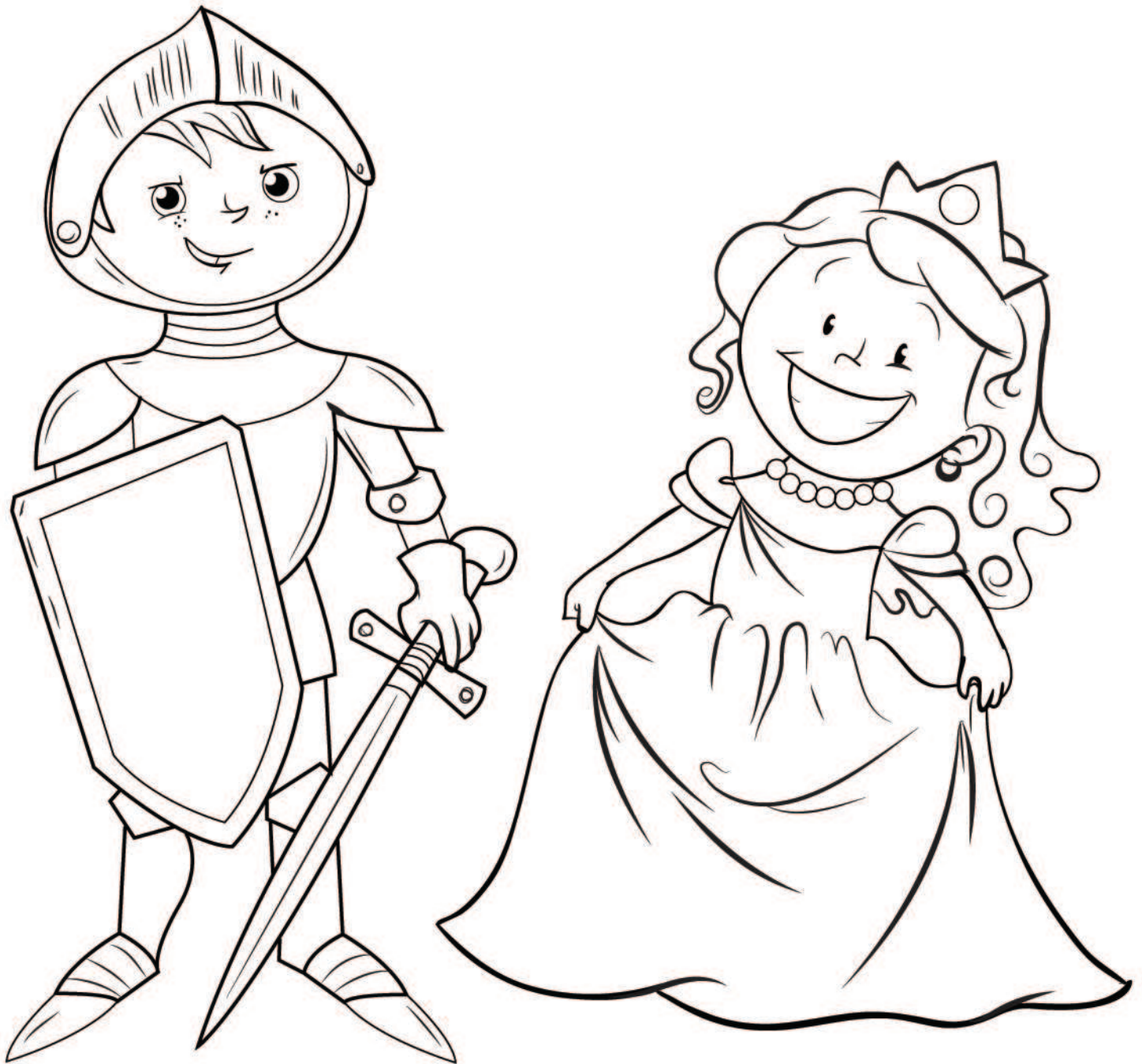

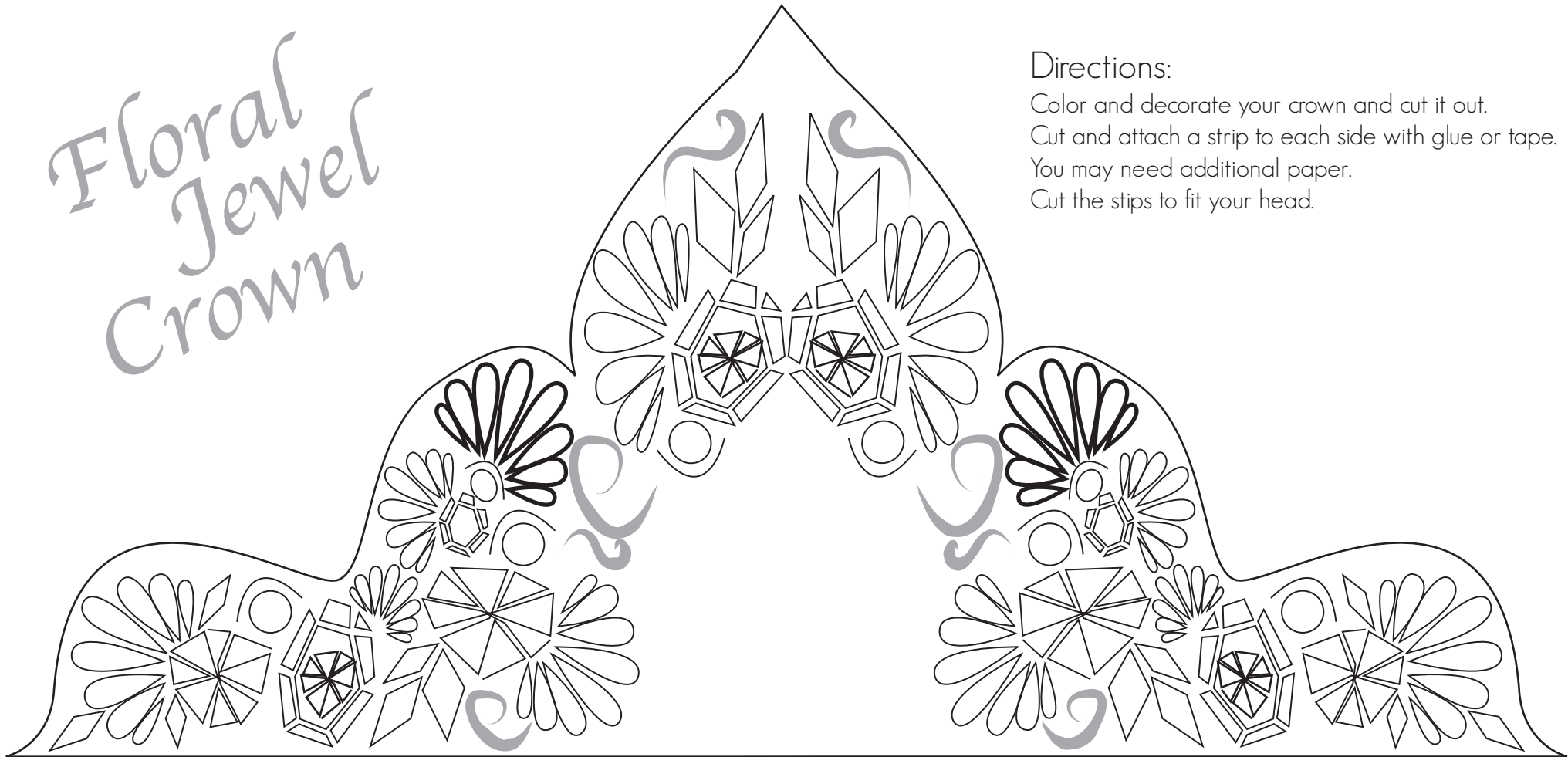

Floral Jewel Crown

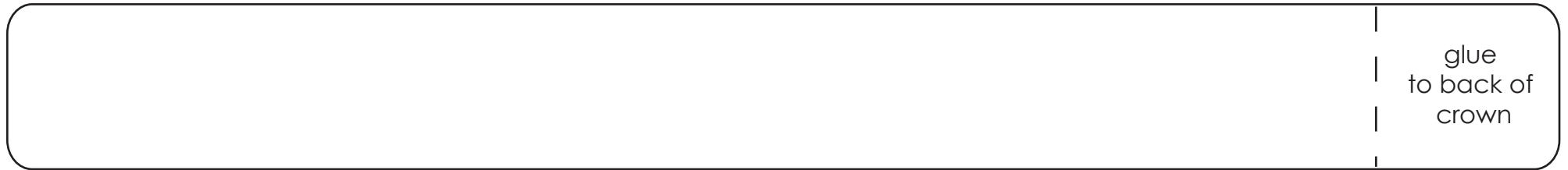


Directions:
