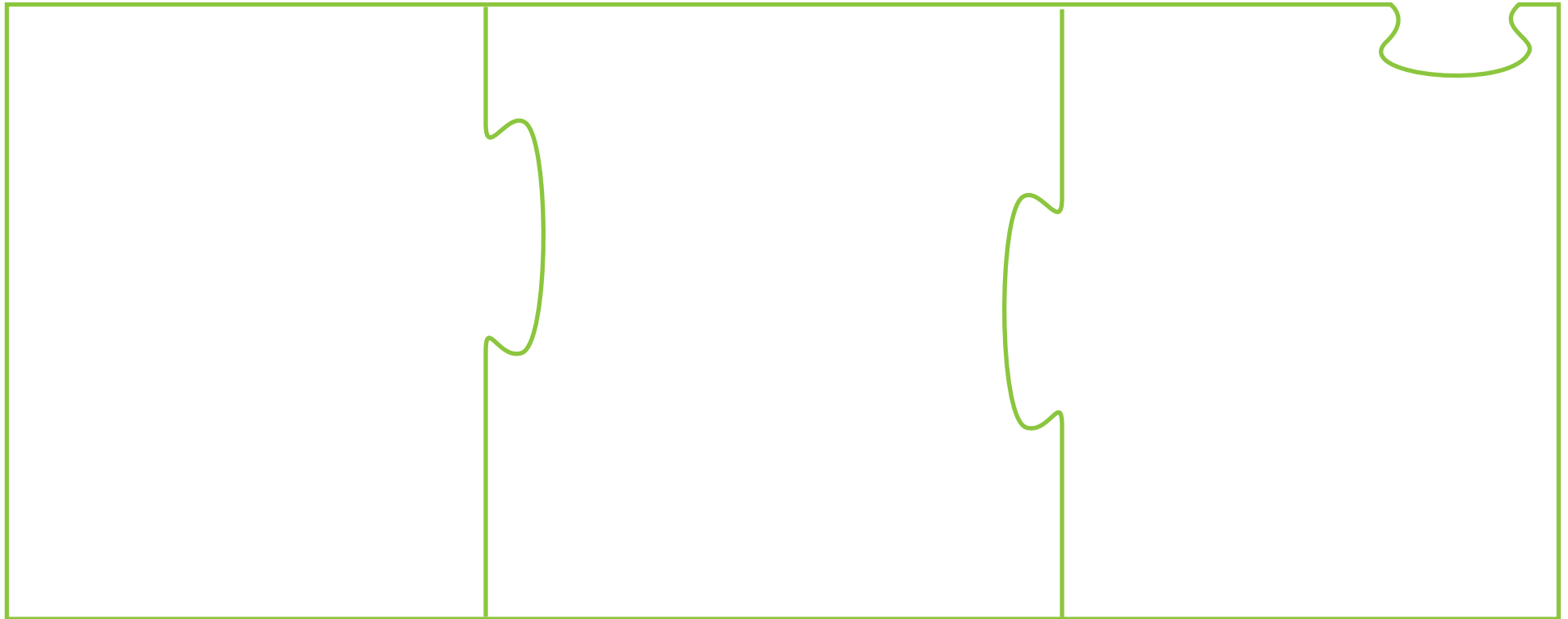
Draw the Story
