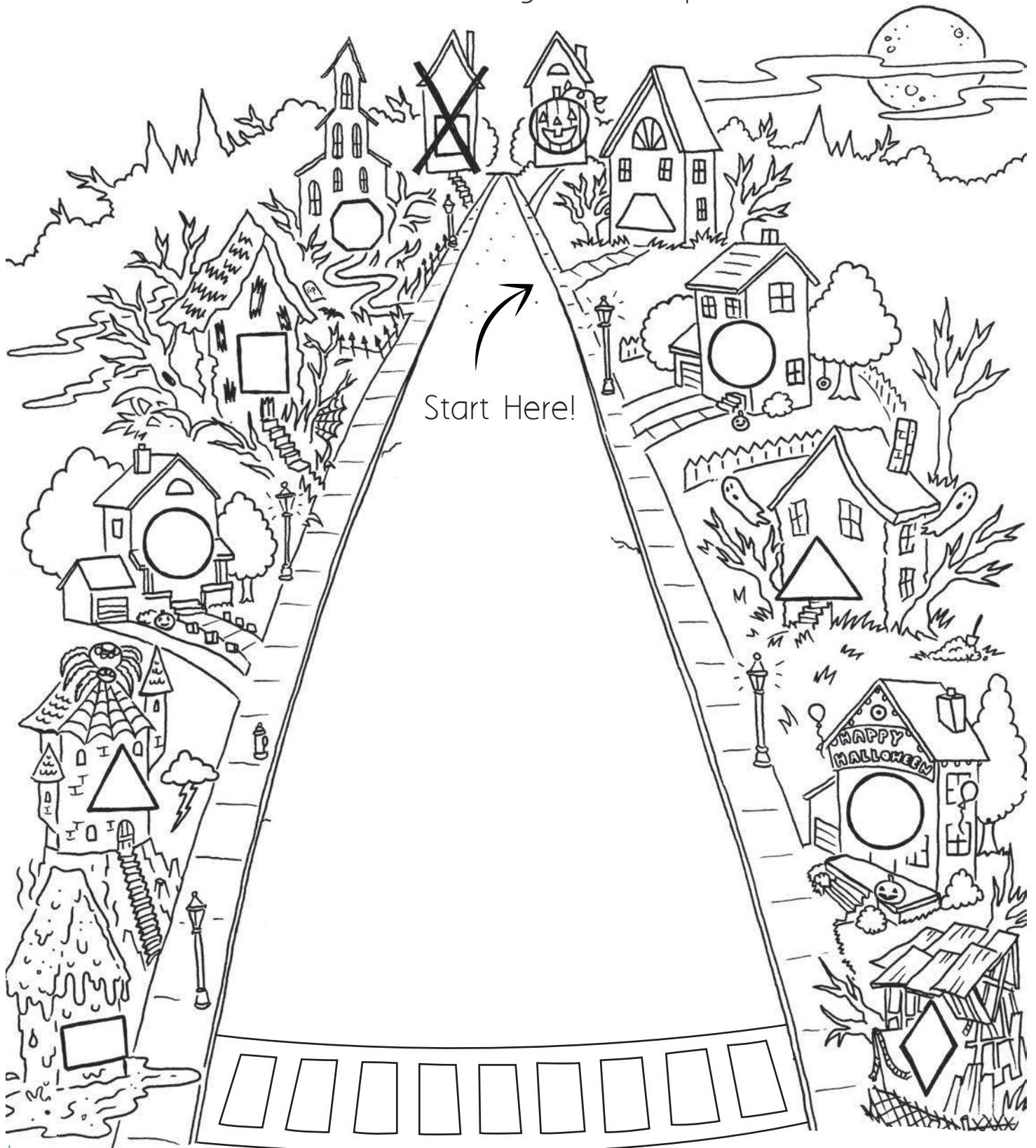

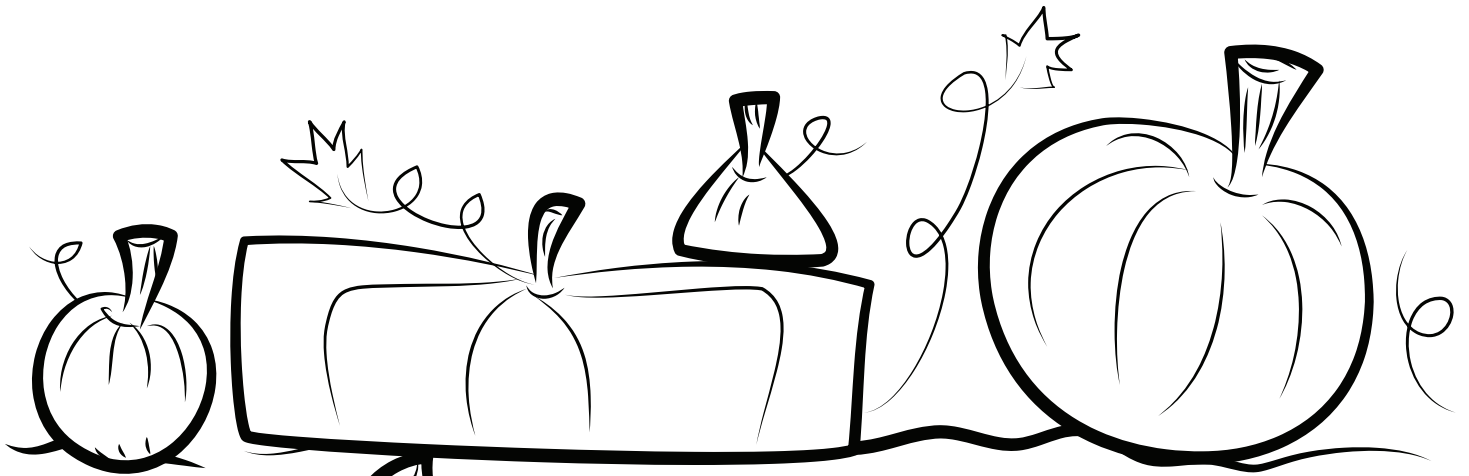

Follow the circles on the path to find the best treats and avoid the tricksters! Turn each circle into a pumpkin by adding a stem and lines that go from top to bottom.

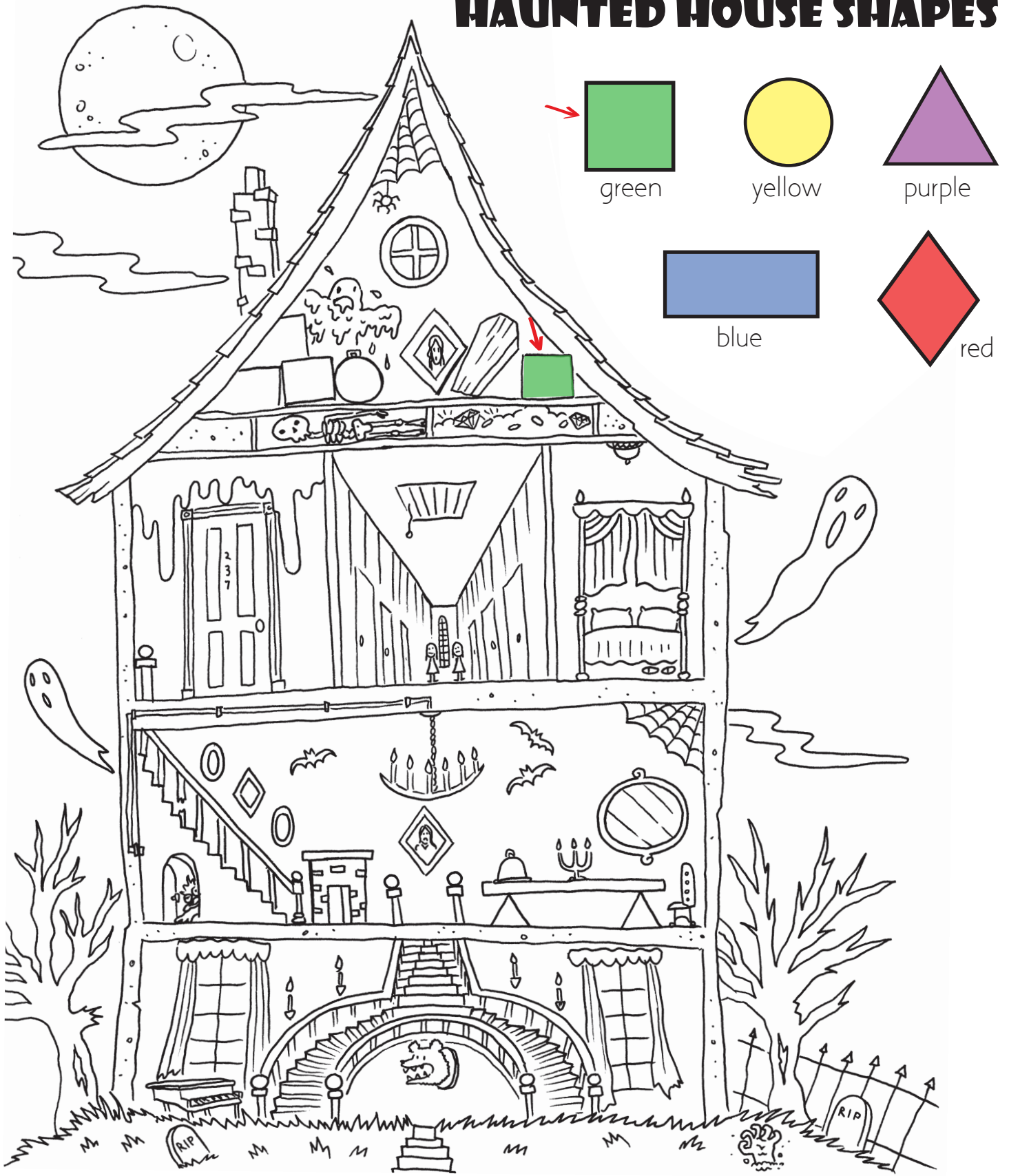


PUMPKIN PATCH

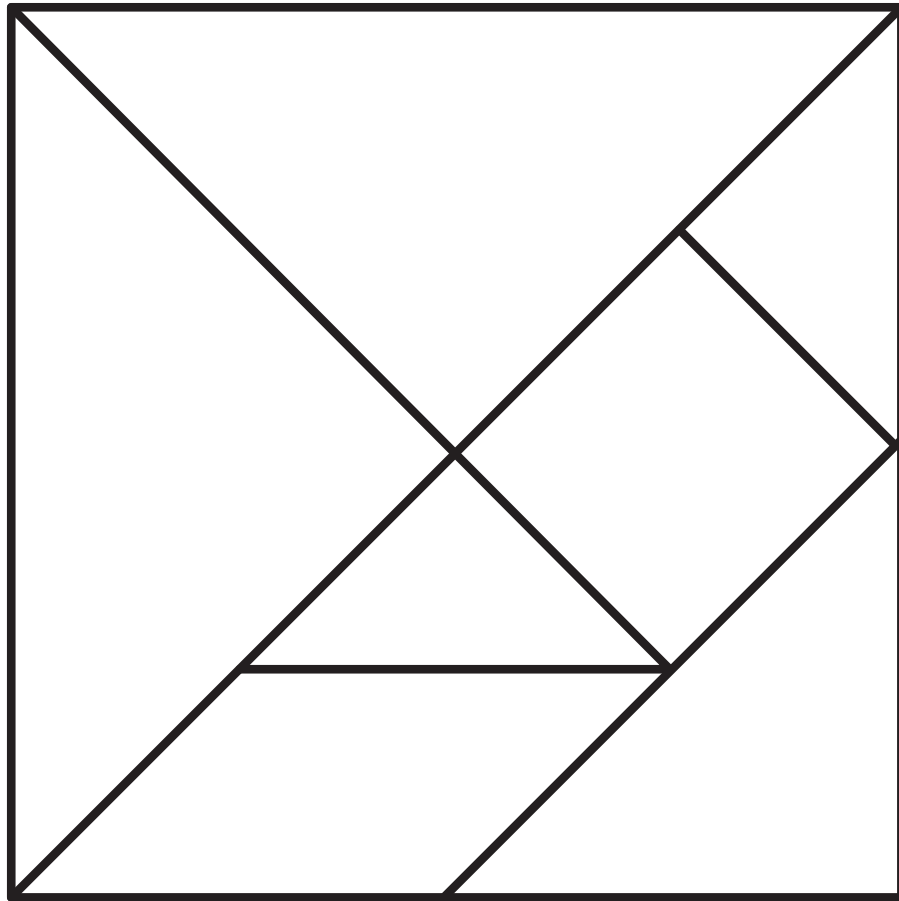

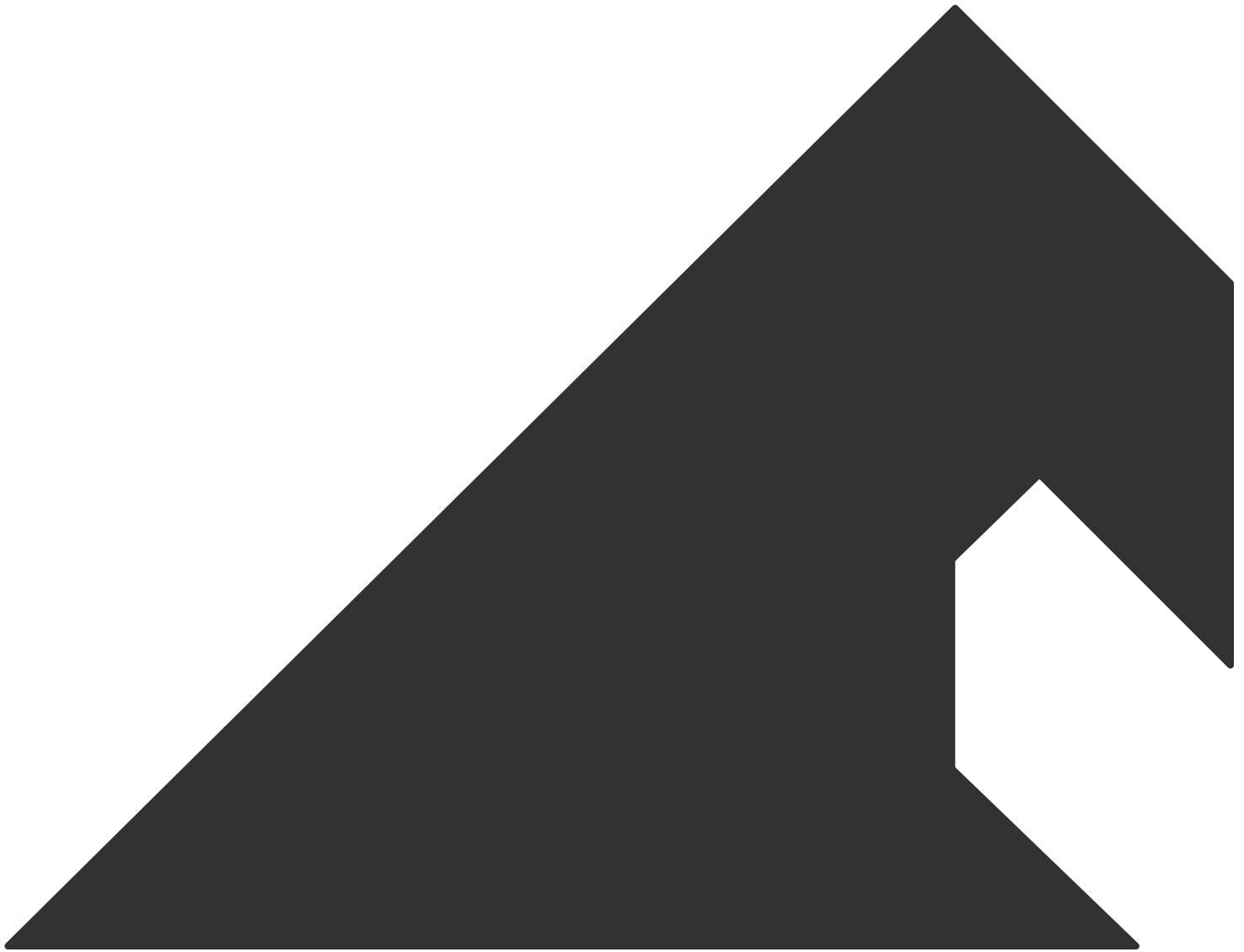
Color and cut out the tangram pieces. Then use them to make new and interesting designs!

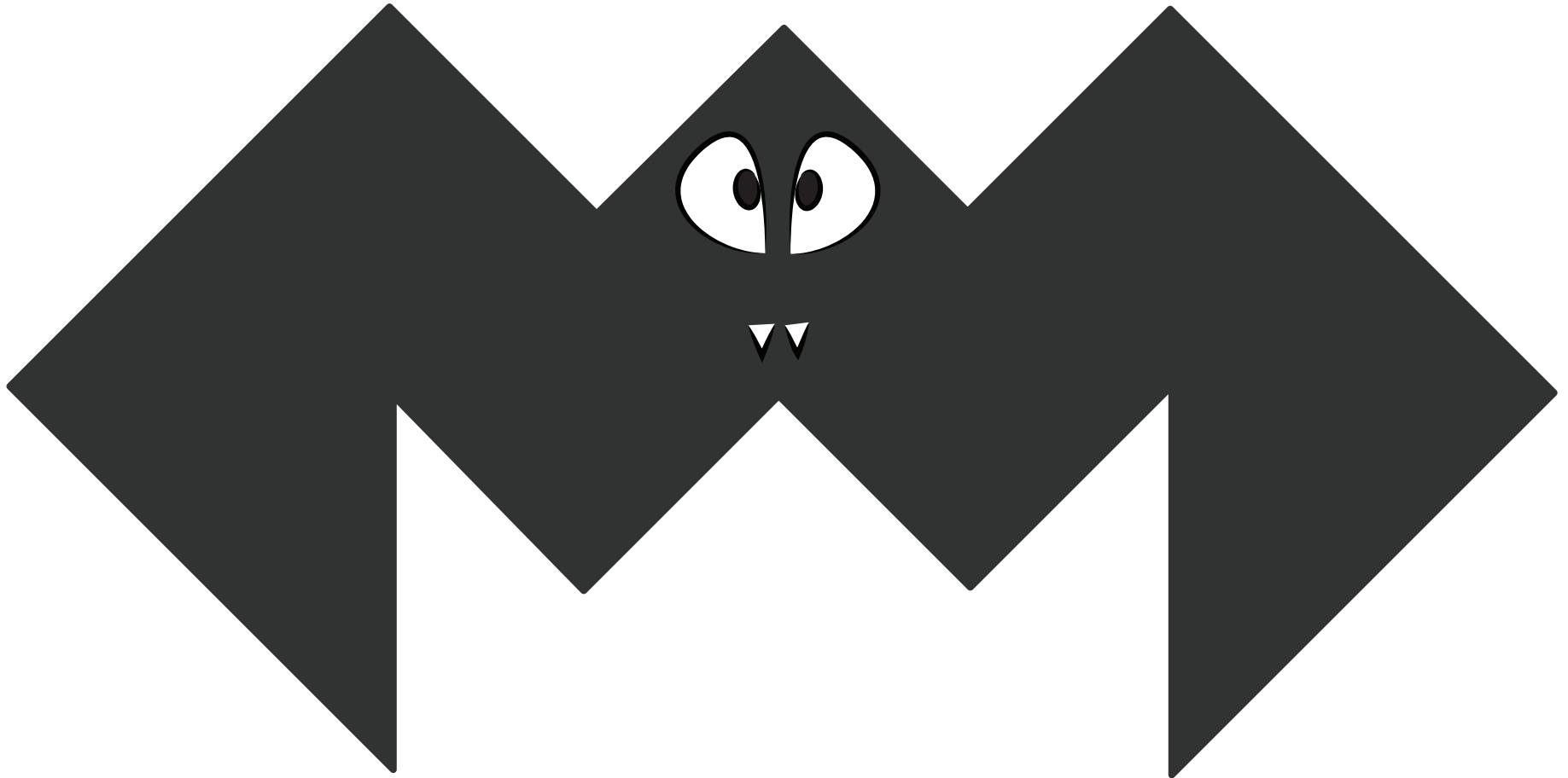

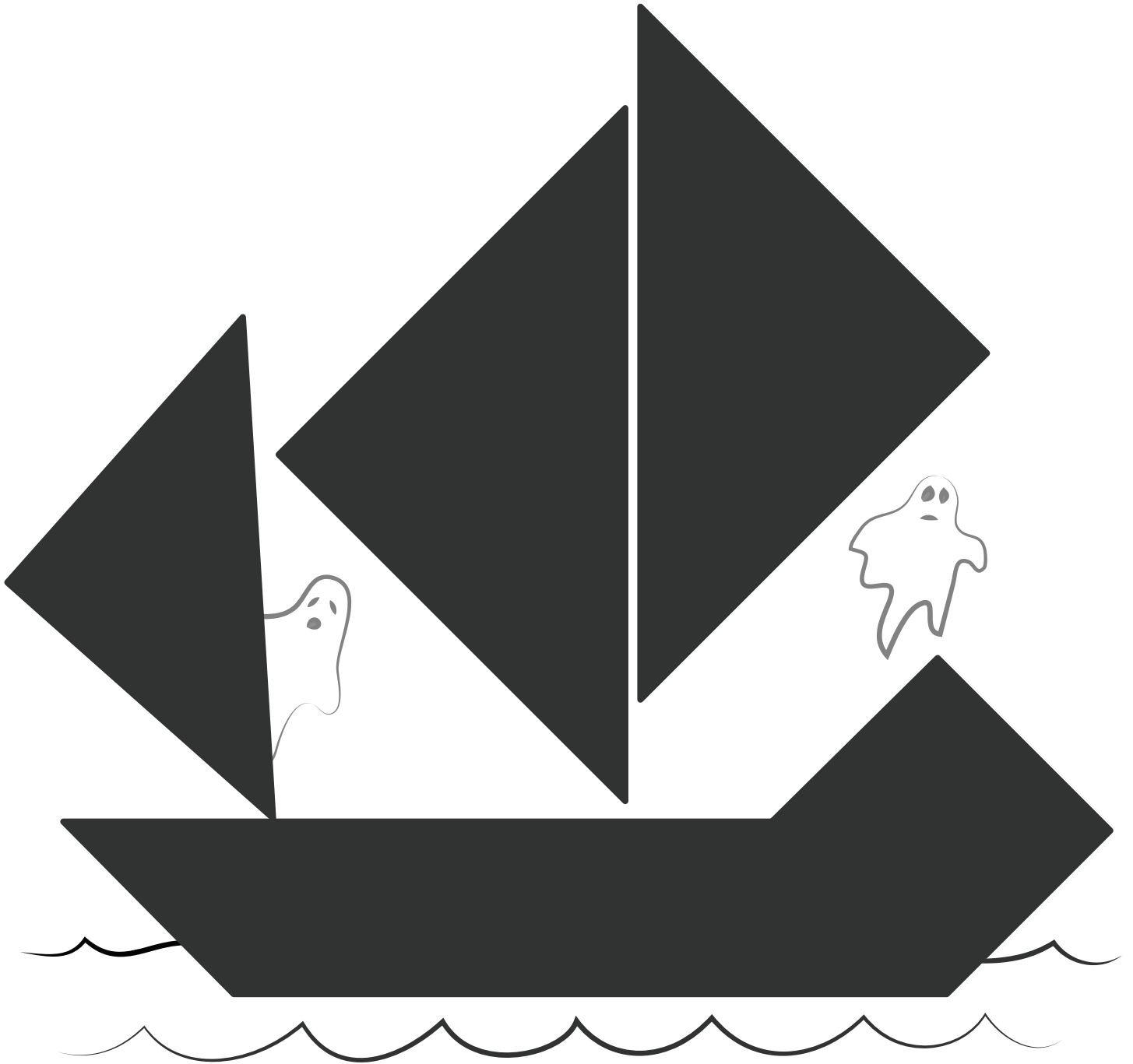

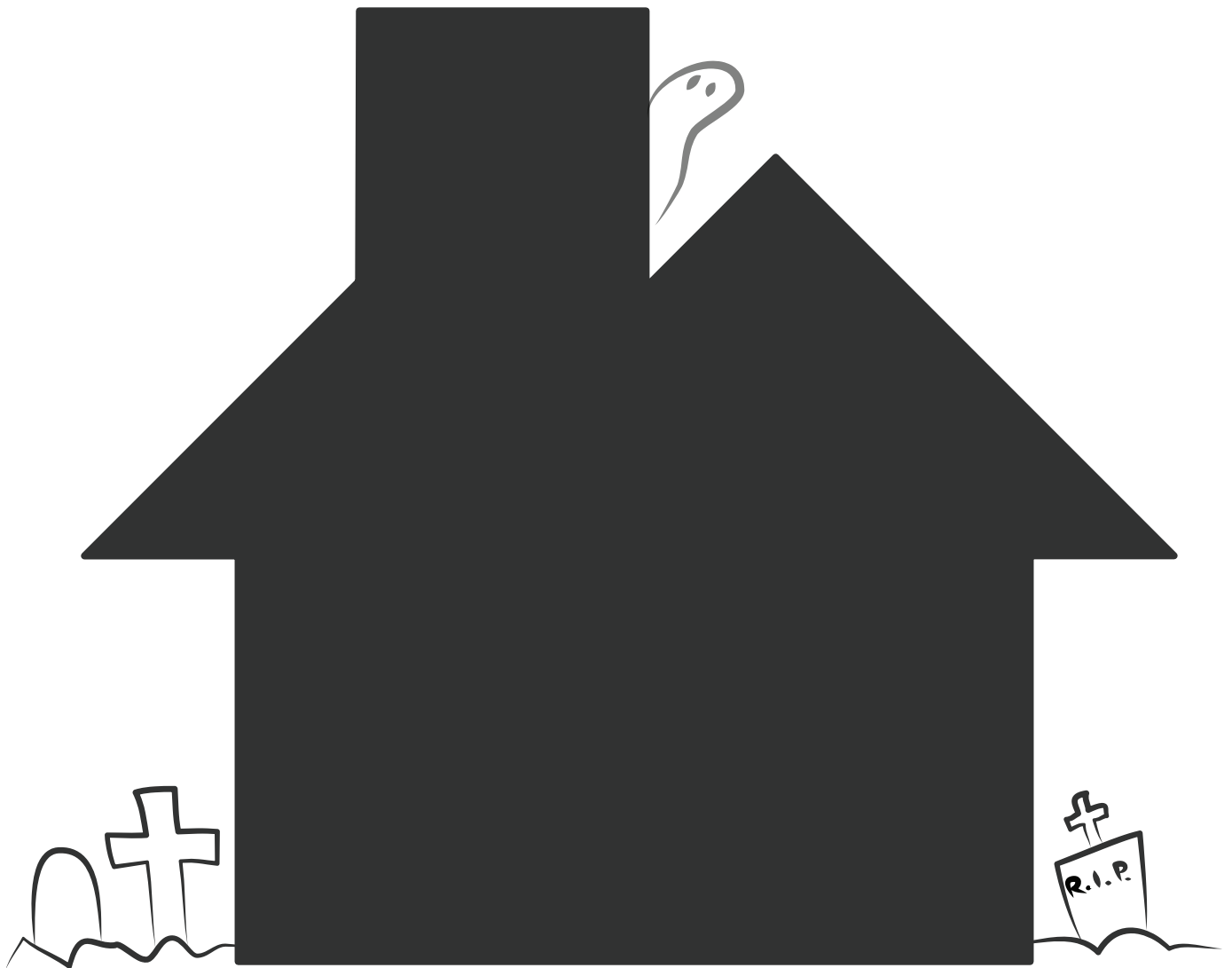
GHOST SHIP TANGRAM

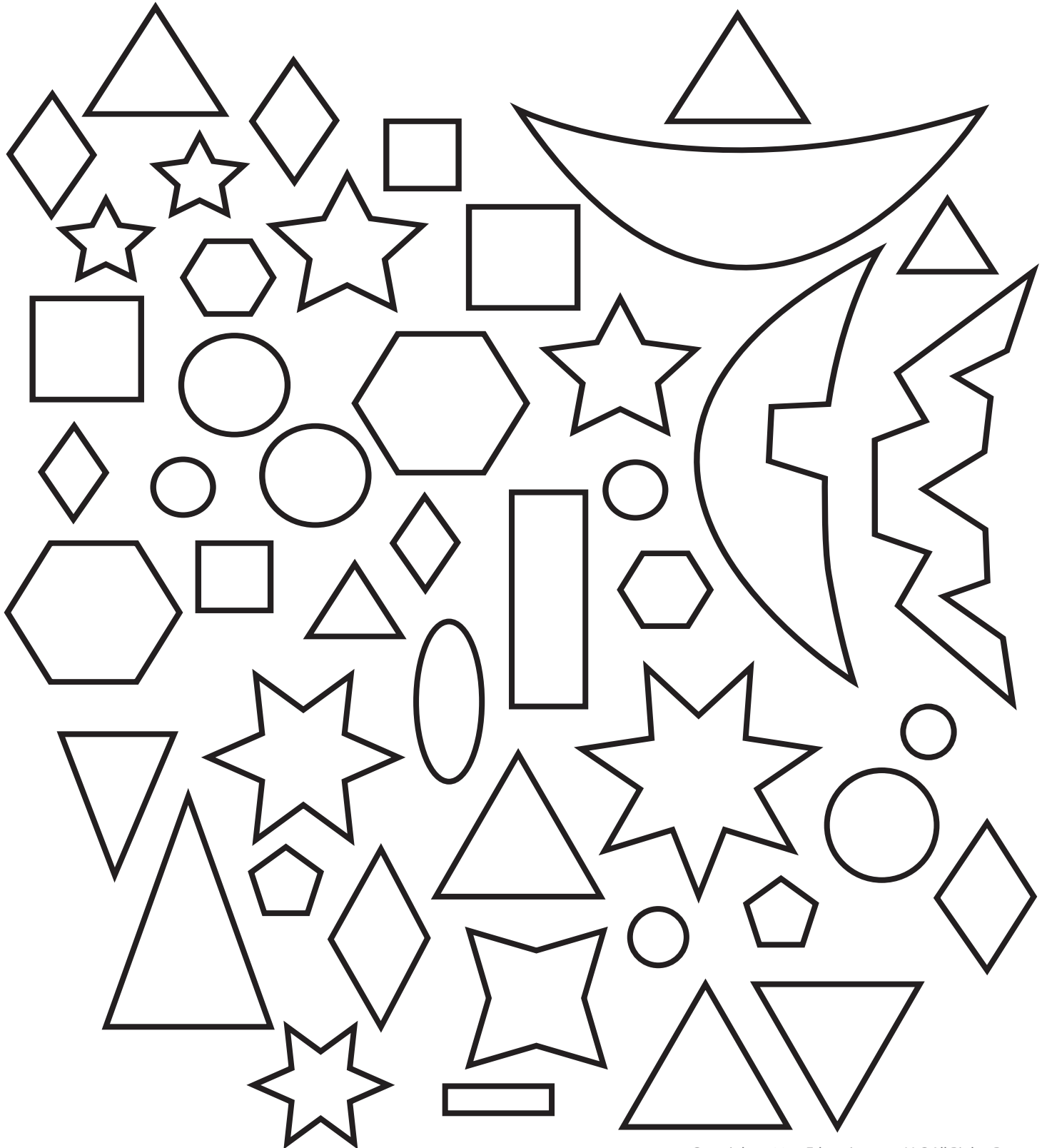

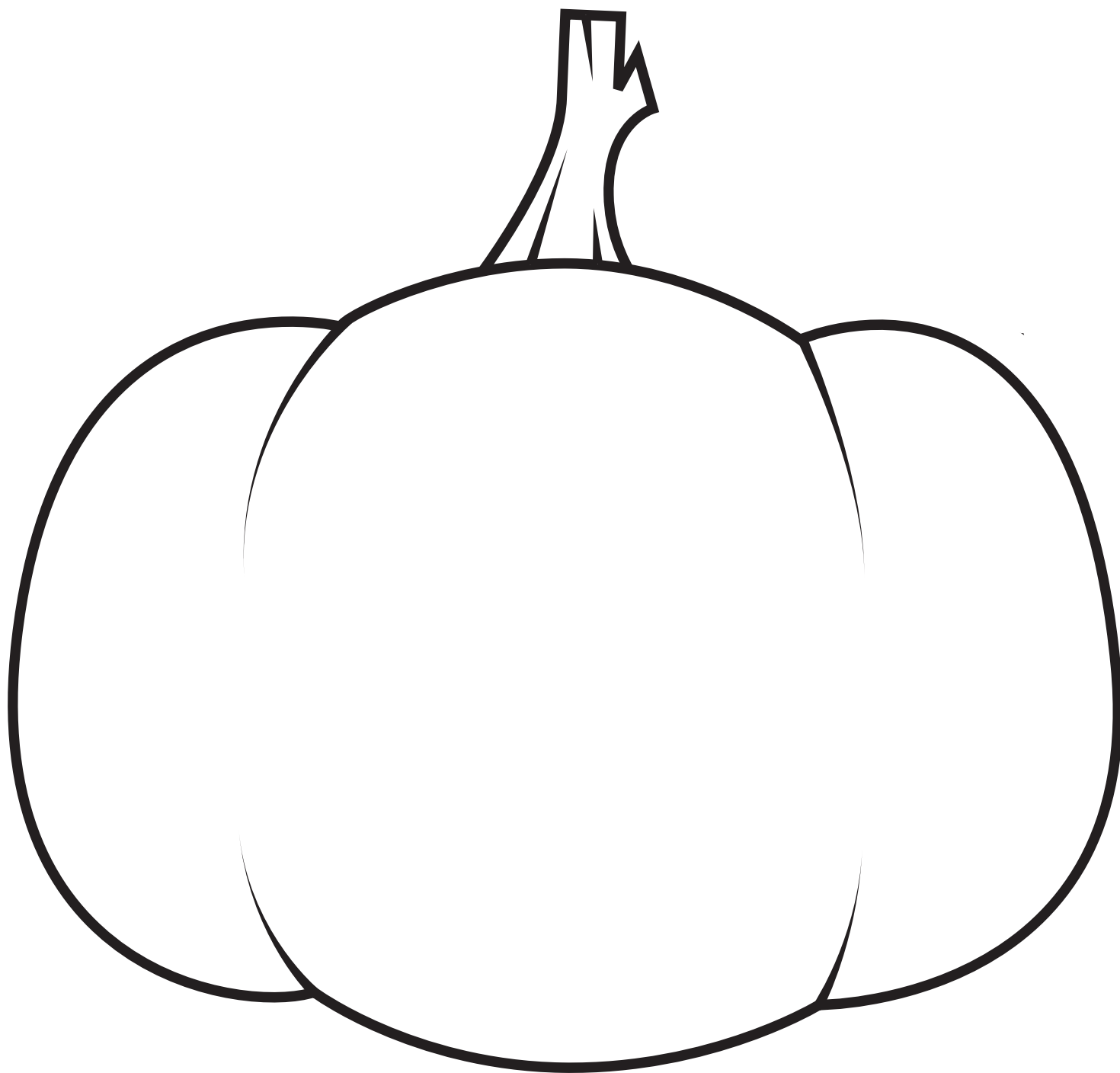

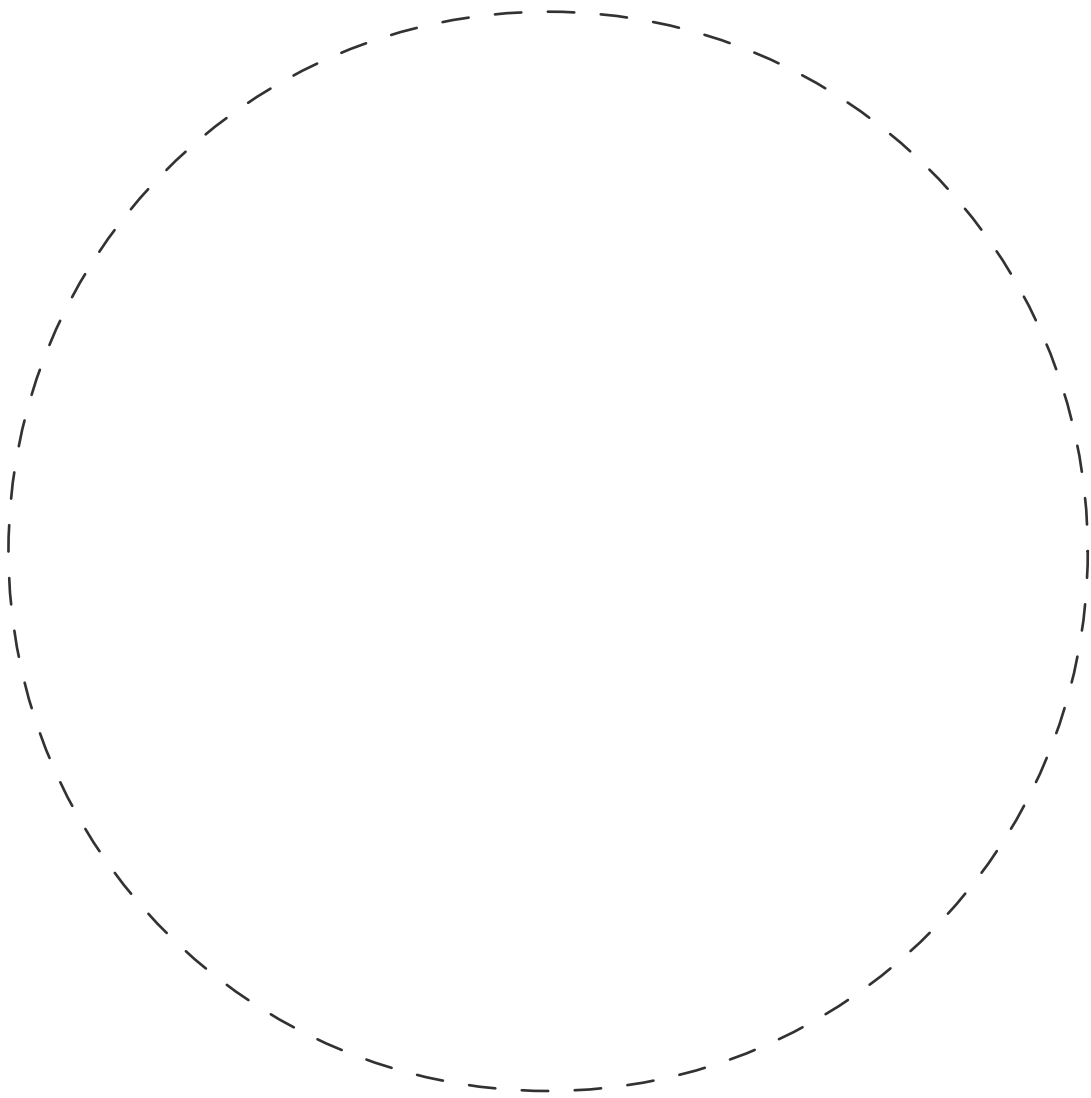
HALLOWEEN SHAPE MONSTER

Glue

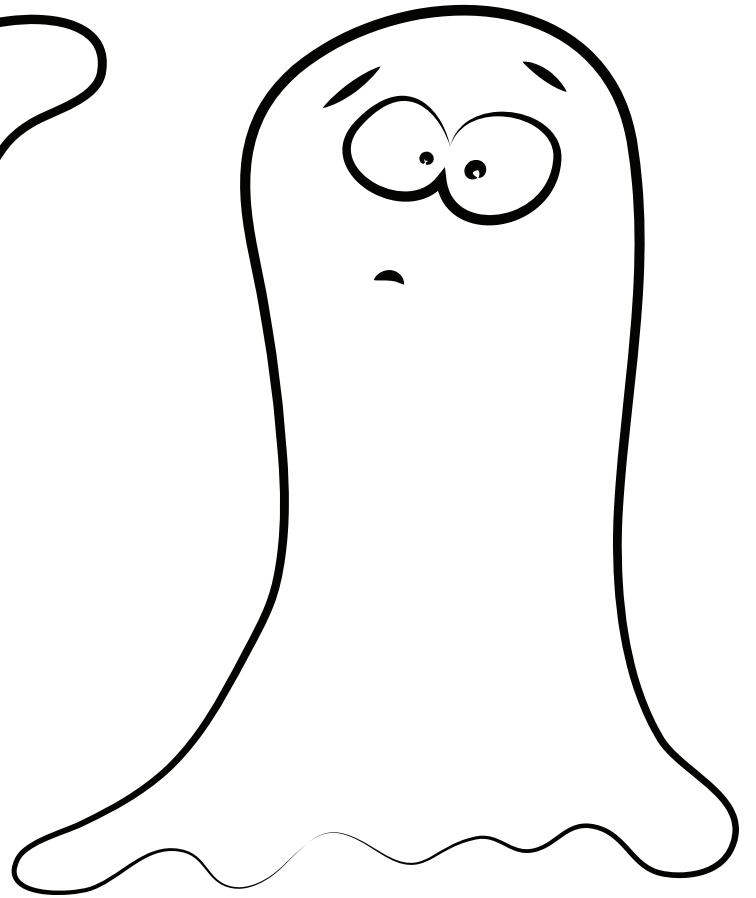

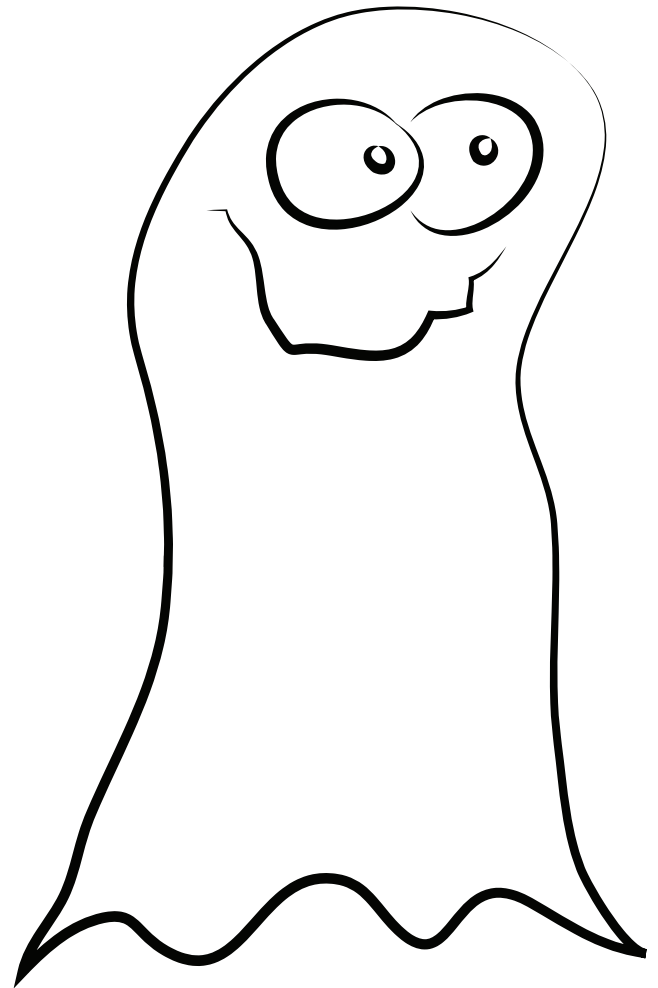
Make a set of these adorable ghost silhouettes to use in a game that helps kids practice describing location!

Example: "I found my ghost hiding under the table."







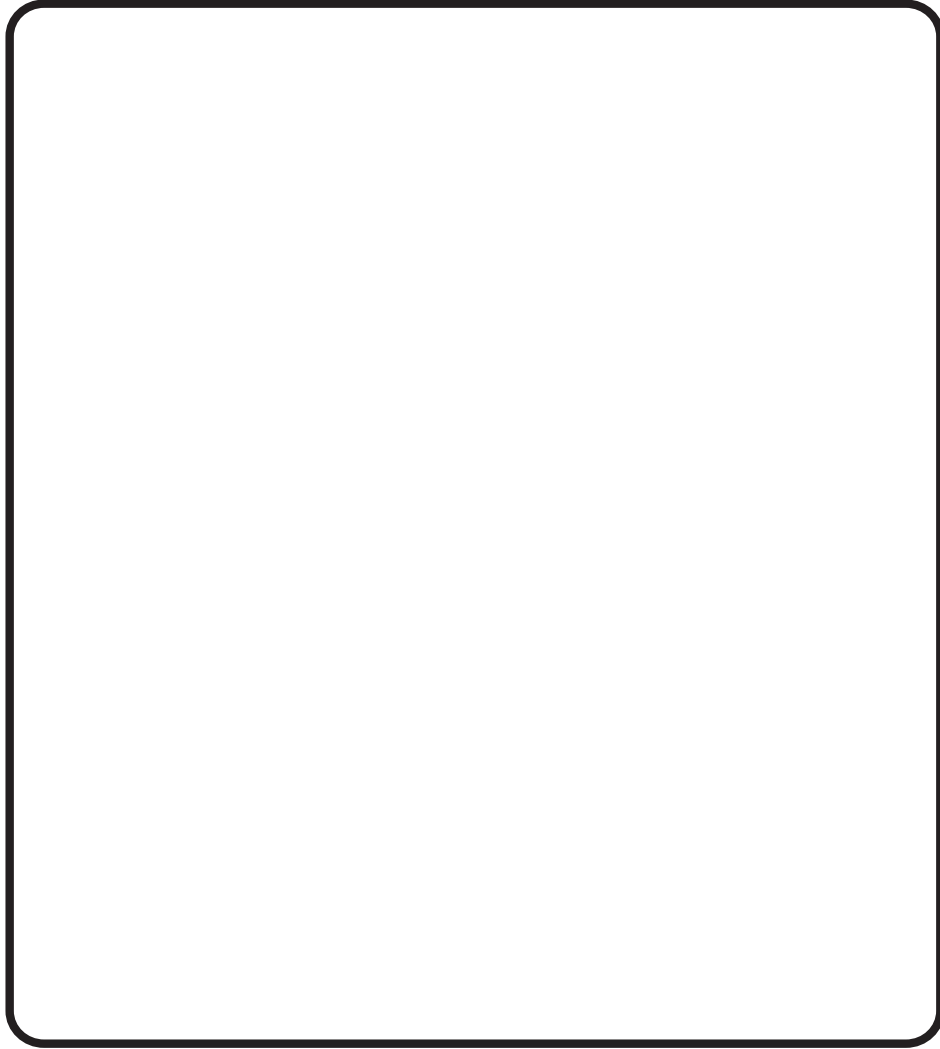
