- Alcatraz Island* : It was a federal prison from 1934 to 1963.
- Golden Gate Bridge* : It is one of the most famous symbols of San Francisco.
- Cable Cars* : It is a very popular attraction for tourists.
- Lombard Street* : An east-west street with eight **hairpin turns** (= *virage en lacet*).
- Painted Ladies* : Victorian houses repainted in bright colours. You can see them in the popular TV series *Full House*.
- Transamerica Pyramid* : The second-tallest skyscraper in the Financial District of S.F.
- Twin Peaks* : Two prominent **hills** (= *collines*). Also named "Eureka" and "Noe", they are about 282m high.
- The Golden Gate Park* : A large urban park. It is over 4.8km long east to west.
- Grace Cathedral* *China Town*
- Coit Tower* : A 64-metre tower offering panoramic views over the city and the bay.
- Walt Disney Family Museum* *China Beach*
- The Exploratorium* : A museum of science, technology and arts.
- Oracle Park* : A baseball park. It is the home of the San Francisco Giants.
- de Young Museum* : A fine arts museum. The American collection consists of over 1,000 paintings, 800 sculptures and 3,000 decorative arts objects.
- Fisherman's Wharf* : A popular tourist attraction in S.F. There are seafood restaurants, and there is also a **sea lion** (= *otarie*) colony.
- Castro Theatre* : A popular movie palace. It was built in 1922 and the theatre has over 1,400 seats.
