Mission : Write the corresponding letter for each place on the list.

- Central Park* : It is the most visited park in the USA. It first opened in 1857.
- Brooklyn Bridge* : It is one of the oldest suspension bridges. It is 1,825m long and it goes over the East River. It connects Manhattan and Brooklyn.
- Flatiron Building* : This **skyscraper** (= *gratte-ciel*), finished in 1902, has a triangular shape.
- Statue of Liberty* *Chinatown* *Saint Patrick's Cathedral*
- Empire State Building* : Completed in 1931, this skyscraper is 381m tall and has 102 **floors** (= *étages*). You can see it in the movie *King Kong*.
- Time Square* : It is a major commercial and **pedestrian area** (= *zone piétonne*) famous for its big screens and Broadway show **billboards** (= *panneaux publicitaires*).
- Museum of Natural History* *Washington Square Arch*
- Ellis Island* : Located opposite the Statue of Liberty, it was used for immigrants coming from other countries to the United States.
- Strawberry Fields* : It is a section in Central Park dedicated to the memory of former Beatles member John Lennon.
- 9/11 Memorial* *Wall Street* : It is home of the New York **Stock Exchange** (= *la bourse*).
- Madison Square Garden* : An arena home of the New York Knicks basketball team.
- Chrysler Building* : This skyscraper has 77 floors and the top is in the shape of a crown. There are **eagles** (= *aigles*) on the 61st floor.
- Freedom Tower* : The tallest building in America. It is near the 9/11 Memorial.
- Rockefeller Center* : Famous for its annual Christmas tree lighting. You have a beautiful view over Central Park from there.
- United Nations Headquarters* : The place where leaders and presidents from all over the world reunite to discuss world peace.
- Metropolitan Museum of Art* : Also called "The Met", it is the largest art museum in the USA with over two millions **works** (= *oeuvres*).
- Guggenheim Museum* : It has a white, circular shape.
