Mission : Write the corresponding letter for each place on the list.

- Stratosphere Tower* : It is 350.2 metre tall and offers the best view over the city.
- Luxor Las Vegas*: Its casino has over 2,000 slot machines and 87 table games.
The hotel is named after the city of Luxor in Egypt.
- Adventure Dome Theme Park* : It currently offers 25 rides and attractions, a 18-hole miniature golf and a video game arcade.
- Caesars Palace* : A luxury hotel and casino with a Roman Empire style.
- New York New York Hotel* *Paris Las Vegas* *Titanic Museum*
- Graceland Wedding Chapel* : Over 100,000 weddings are performed each year.
Elvis impersonators conduct the ceremonies.
- Freemont Street Experience* : A **pedestrian mall** (= *une zone piétonne*). The main attraction is the LED display canopy. More than 12 million LED lamps illuminate it.
- Shark Reef Aquarium* *Circus Circus Casino*
- Excalibur Hotel* : This place is named after the mythical sword of King Arthur. Its facade is a stylized image of a castle.
- Hand of Faith* : It is a **nugget** (= *une pépite*) of gold that was found by Kevin Hillier in Australia in 1980. It weighs 27.21 kg
- Cirque du Soleil Shows* *Pinball Hall of Fame* : **pinball** (= *le flipper*)
- The Venetian* : The resort complex is the world's second-largest hotel. The hotel uses Venice, Italy, as its design inspiration.
- Bellagio* : A luxury resort, hotel and casino on the Las Vegas Strip. There is a lake between the building and the Strip, which houses the Fountains of Bellagio, a large dancing water fountain synchronized to music. Many professional poker players like playing there.
- Madame Tussauds Wax Museum* : It features over 100 wax figures of celebrities.
Wax (= *de la cire*)
