The vein bulging occurs when the walls of the veins get weakened and damaged over time. Veins are responsible to carry deoxygenated blood to the heart. If the blood will not reach the heart, it might lead to cardiovascular diseases. There is a variety of procedures for the removal of varicose veins. The patient might undergo one of the following treatments, depending upon the severity of the issue.



Finding the right treatment will help you experience freedom from venous insufficiency like varicose veins. [Laser treatment for Varicose Veins in legs](#) is used to treat minor and small varicose or spider veins. Endovenous treatment can treat larger varicose veins in the legs. The process involves a laser fiber that is passed through a catheter into the veins. The process is watched on an ultrasound screen. Laser treatment is less painful than vein stripping and surgeries and has a shorter recovery time.

Sclerotherapy is a process that involves injecting a chemical that acts as an irritant to kill the unhealthy veins. The process directs the flow of the blood towards the heart through healthy veins. The internal lining of the treated veins swells; the clotted blood will begin to break down and causes the vessel to disappear.

A **vein stripping** is a method that involves the physical removal of the damaged veins. If the number of damaged veins is small, the doctor might choose this method to remove the selected veins from the site. In this procedure, an incision will be made and the vein will be cut, tied off and completely stripped out.
