

# Wooden box for bees

This is a wooden box for bees to help them survive the winter and find shelter in summer and autumn.



# Resources

To make the box I need: 4 boards of different lengths, a piece of dicta or particle board for the back of the box, bamboo sticks, clay, a wood block with holes and a metal mesh to close the box, a hammer, pincers nails, a saw and a measuring tape.



# Workflow

First, measure the appropriate length of the boards and cut them. Then, using a hammer and nails, we join the pieces together. We nail dicta or chipboard to the back of the shed. We fill the shed with clay, which will help to glue the wooden block and bamboo sticks. We close the finished and filled box with a metal mesh and hang it on a tree or fence in a quiet place. We patiently wait for the first inhabitants 😊.
