

THE ROTATING TREE OF SEASONS

Summary

Let's create a rotating tree of the seasons. This creative activity will allow you to revisit what trees look like in each of the 4 seasons, as well as develop your creativity and drawing skills.

Materials

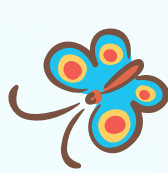
paper plates - 2 pcs.
coloured pencils and/or markers
eraser
scissors
pin



Workflow

On the first plate, draw the trunk and the foliage of the tree. Cut the foliage out. Colour the trunk. Find the centre of the plate and poke a hole with a pin.





Take the second plate. Find the centre of the plate (the centre of the two plates must be the same) and divide the area of the plate into 4 equal parts. In each of the parts, draw around the foliage of the tree cutted from the first plate.

Draw and colour each of the four foliagees according to the season.

Put the two plates together (the plate with the trunk is at the top, the plate with 4 foliagees is below it), put a pin in the centre and put an eraser under the centre of the bottom plate so that the pin can be inserted. The eraser is needed to prevent the pin from sticking in the hand and to provide the plate to spin.





The result is a tree trunk on the top plate, and on the bottom plate you can see how the foliage changes through the seasons.
