Wooden tower (janga)

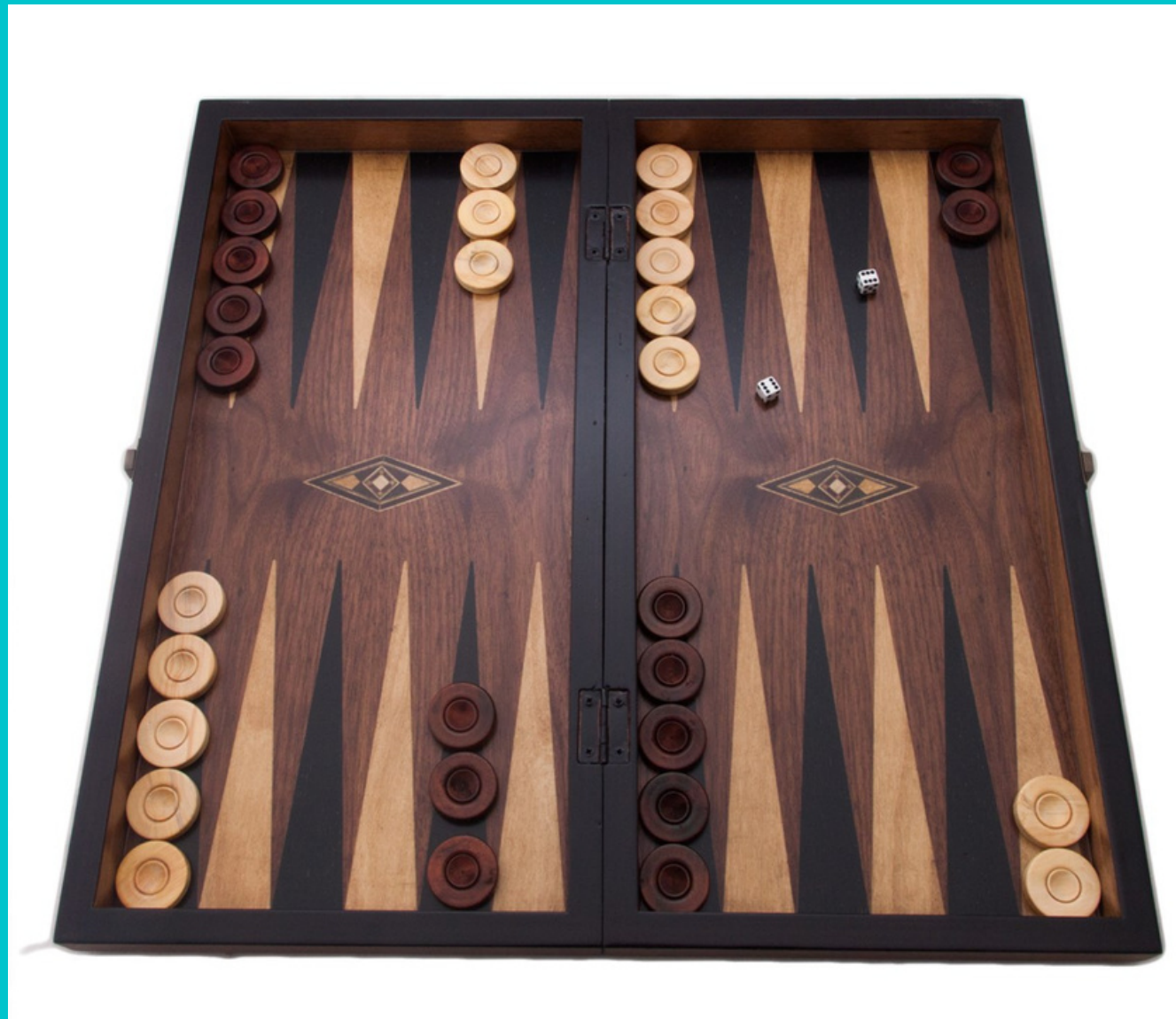
A game popular all over the world. His goal is simple: to remove as many sticks as possible without destroying the tower.

In Eastern countries (Turkey, Arabia, Oman, etc.) a board game is played.

Each player has 15 checkers on their side of the board (one team is white and the other is black). When rolling two dice, you need to move all checkers to the opposite side of the board before your opponent does.

Mikado

This is a mathematical and attentive game. Chopsticks are eaten on the table, which are marked differently. Each marking is a different number of points. Take one stick at a time without touching or disturbing others. Whoever gets the most points wins.

Chess



Logical thinking game. Each piece can only move in a way specific to that piece: pawns forward, knights in an L-shaped path, rooks diagonally, etc. The player who cuts the king wins (the action is called "check" and "checkmate")
