- **the blue color means the Kashubian sky,**
- **navy blue is like the immeasurable depth of the sea,**
- **yellow color expresses cereals ripening in the fields and the sun,**
- **green color symbolizes forests full of animals,**
- **red is like the blood that every Kashubian is ready to shed in defense of his land,**
- **the brown and spell colors represent soil in the field waiting to be sown.**
