

Summary.

We will make a conifer wreath.

For this creative project we will need:

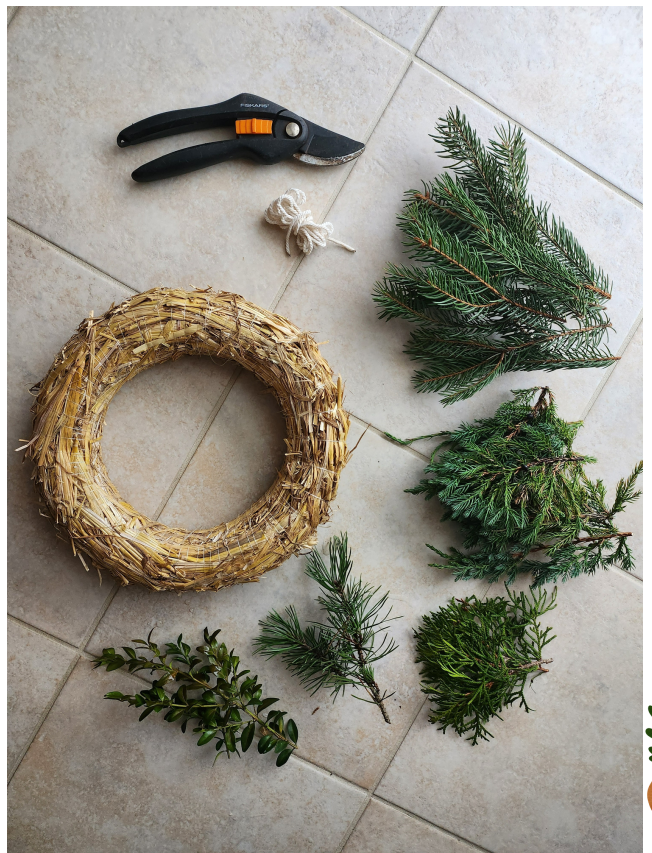
- branches of different conifers or shrubs, or evergreens;
- sturdy thread;
- scissors (preferably garden shears);
- a straw base for the wreath (e.g. 24 cm in diameter);
- decorations as desired (ribbon, artificial berries, etc.).



Workflow.

Go to the woods or find conifers (coniferous shrubs) or evergreens in your neighborhood or garden. Collect their branches in a basket.

Start by placing plant branches around the straw base and secure with thread. You can see the direction in the picture. $\frac{3}{4}$ of the base should be covered (you can leave the bottom without the branches).



When the whole straw base is wrapped with twigs, the wreath can be placed on the table or on the door. If desired, it can be decorated with ribbon, artificial fruit, small bells or other decorations.
