



Christmas trees calendars



Students and their teachers created advent calendars in the form of trees. There was a tree made of cardboard, and another that was made of wooden slats. Lights were pinned on the trees and envelopes with tasks for each day of Advent were attached.

Resources.

To prepare our work we used: scissors, nails and hammer, cardboard, glue, paints, colored adhesive paper, paper bags, hot glue, string, lights, crayons, markers, mini wooden clips.

Workflow.

Cardboard tree.

On a very large, thick cardboard, we drew a tree to resemble a Christmas tree. We cut it out and then painted it green to make it look exactly like a Christmas tree. Next, we made holes in several places and tied strings so that we could hook envelopes on them. We decorated the finished envelopes with art materials and used wooden mini clips to attach them to the strings on the Christmas tree.

Wooden tree.

We adopted several wooden slats, which we cut off in such a way as to obtain the shape of a Christmas tree - from the largest branch to the smallest. We nailed individual slats to the trunk of the Christmas tree, and then painted the whole thing with green wood paint. We glued mini wooden clips with hot glue to the wooden branches, and then hung lights and pinned mini envelopes with tasks.

On each tree we additionally hung a star - one made of paper and the other of wire.
