# Climb the Tree

## Summary:

It's a board game in a shape of a tree and you have to answer some questions about trees.

## Resources:

Board of the game made by us (the best size would be A3), dice, pawns.

## Preparation:

Print the board, prepare dice and as many pawns as is the number of players.

## Activity:

The aim of the game is to be the first player to reach the top of the tree.

The game starts the oldest player by rolling a dice. The players move forward the number of dots thrown on a dice. If you step on a place that has leaves on it, you go to a place it leads to. When you come across a squirrel, you answer a question, if you get the answer wrong, go back 4 places.
