Plastic and residual waste

Inside we have two waste bins. One for residual waste and one for plastic.



Old paper

There is a box in the pantry where we collect the old paper. Once every two months, this is collected by a primary school in our area. They use it to fund school trips and other things.

The containers

Mashed basil leaves are has a natural antibacterial substance to rub out acne and mold.



Compost

We throw a lot of food waste or green waste on the compost pile. This is then converted by the worms.
