

Wisdom Teeth Removal; What do you Expect?

Wisdom teeth are the last teeth to grow in your mouth. There are four, one each in the corner of your mouth at the back. Usually, they erupt between the age of seventeen to twenty-five, sometimes they can erupt later or earlier. The main problems with wisdom teeth consist due to impaction of them leading to severe pain, infection, and other complications. You may also experience bad breath, impacted wisdom teeth that can develop a cyst and rarely form a tumor if left untreated. This type of condition requires the [best dentist near me](#).



When there is adequate space for the wisdom teeth and they don't erupt normally as they should like another tooth, there may be some issues including soreness when they erupt. Moreover, you may experience discomfort when you have not sufficient space within the mouth for proper eruption of wisdom teeth, therefore they may become impacted. This means it can remain at an angle as tipped against the tooth ahead of it. Impacted wisdom teeth may produce a lot of issues like pain and swelling.

What are the common symptoms of Impacted wisdom teeth?

Indications of impacted wisdom teeth may include:

- Bad breath and bad taste.
- Severe tooth-ache.
- Swollen gums.

- Difficulty in opening the mouth.
- Severe pain while biting or eating.
- Ulcers on the cheek.
- May experience ear-ache.

The following problems may cause frequent discomfort, so it is essential to get the correct treatment timely.



Other than that, you may experience a wisdom tooth infection, it can become serious if left untreated.

What is the procedure of Wisdom Teeth Removal Near Me?

Wisdom teeth removal is a surgical procedure that takes at least forty-five minutes to complete.

During the procedure, your dentist will inject the affected area with a local anesthetic to numb it so that you won't experience any kind of pain. He/she may give you sedation to relax during the procedure. The dentist will make incisions into gum bones to eliminate the infected tooth. After that, he/she will stitch the wounds seal off. These stitches are usually dissolved after a few days. Also, he/she may put gauze pads in your mouth to absorb blood.

After the surgery, you might be able to return back to your normal activities. But if the surgery is conducted under general anesthesia, you may feel drowsy and you will need somebody's help to drive you home safely. Most people have slight pain after the surgery that will disappear after a few days.

You won't feel any pain as the doctors use a local anesthetic to numb the affected area. However, if you feel pain or any kind of discomfort during the [wisdom teeth removal](#), tell your doctor immediately, he/she may give you more anesthetic.
