A tooth restoration procedure helps the tooth to restructure, provide strengths, and better function to get an improved smile and facial appearance. A dental crown is a tooth-shaped structure with natural coloring “caps” that are placed over the tooth to restore its shape, size, and strength. It is effective in hiding the tooth surface’s imperfections.



A tooth crown may be recommended when you have gone through a root canal and teeth filling. Sometimes people use this option due to aesthetic concerns as it helps to get a shiny smile. An **emergency dentist** may also help in tooth restoration.

## **Types Of Dental Crowns:**

### **1. Gold crowns**

These crowns are alloys of copper and other metals like nickel or chrome. The main benefits of these crowns are their strength and durability. This option for a dental crown is in high demand due to its shiny appearance and color.

### **2. Porcelain Crowns**

It is the most widely used option for dental crowns nowadays. They are completely manufactured with porcelain material. These types of crowns match your surrounding teeth providing a natural look.



### **3. Porcelain Fused-to-Metal Crowns (PFM)**

It is another popular option for dental crowns. They are effective for both reasons strength and aesthetic appearance.

### **4. Zirconia Crowns**

It is a new material that contains the strength of metals along with the aesthetics of porcelain crowns.

### **5. E- MAX: Lithium Disilicate Crowns**

It is a new advanced type of crown in dentistry, known as E-Max. It is a variety of all-ceramic crowns of lithium disilicate.

### **Cost of Dental Crown:**

A dental crown may cost between \$500 to \$2000 or more depending on whether you have insurance or not. Also, it depends on how many procedures will be required for your current dental state. If you are wishing for a low-cost solution, you can opt for an indirect resin crown that can be available in \$400-600 approximately. It can be considered as a large dental filling prepared in your dentist's lab.

### **Dental Crown Procedure:**

The procedure depends on the type you select for the treatment. Generally, the steps involved during the process are:

- The dentist will ready your tooth by performing a thorough cleaning. Maybe it requires the elimination of tooth decay or root canal or both.
- He/She will make a mold of your tooth so that an actually fitted crown may be prepared.
- Until your permanent crown is being prepared, the dentist may use a temporary restoration to protect your tooth.
- After a week, your dentist will place a permanent crown.
