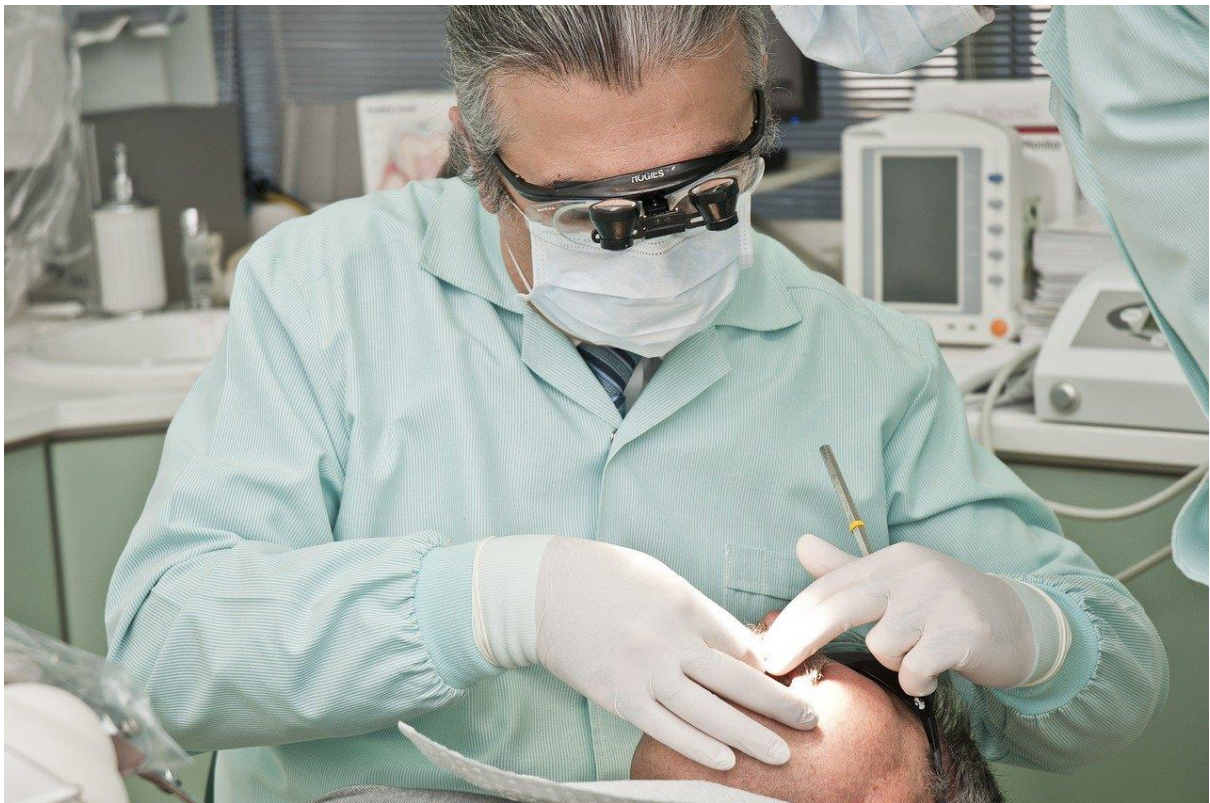


Can Periodontitis Be Cured?

Further, the dentists use a tiny ruler called a probe to compute the pockets on the gums. The test is generally painless. If the tartar, plaque, or both of them are found on teeth then the dentists will eliminate the particles as part of dental cleaning. The dentist will generally take an X-ray and refer you to the periodontist. A periodontists is the dentist who is an expert in **Gum Disease Treatment** and diagnosing the problem./

The main aim of **periodontal disease treatment** is to control the infection. The number and kinds of treatment will be different and depend on the area of the gum disease.
