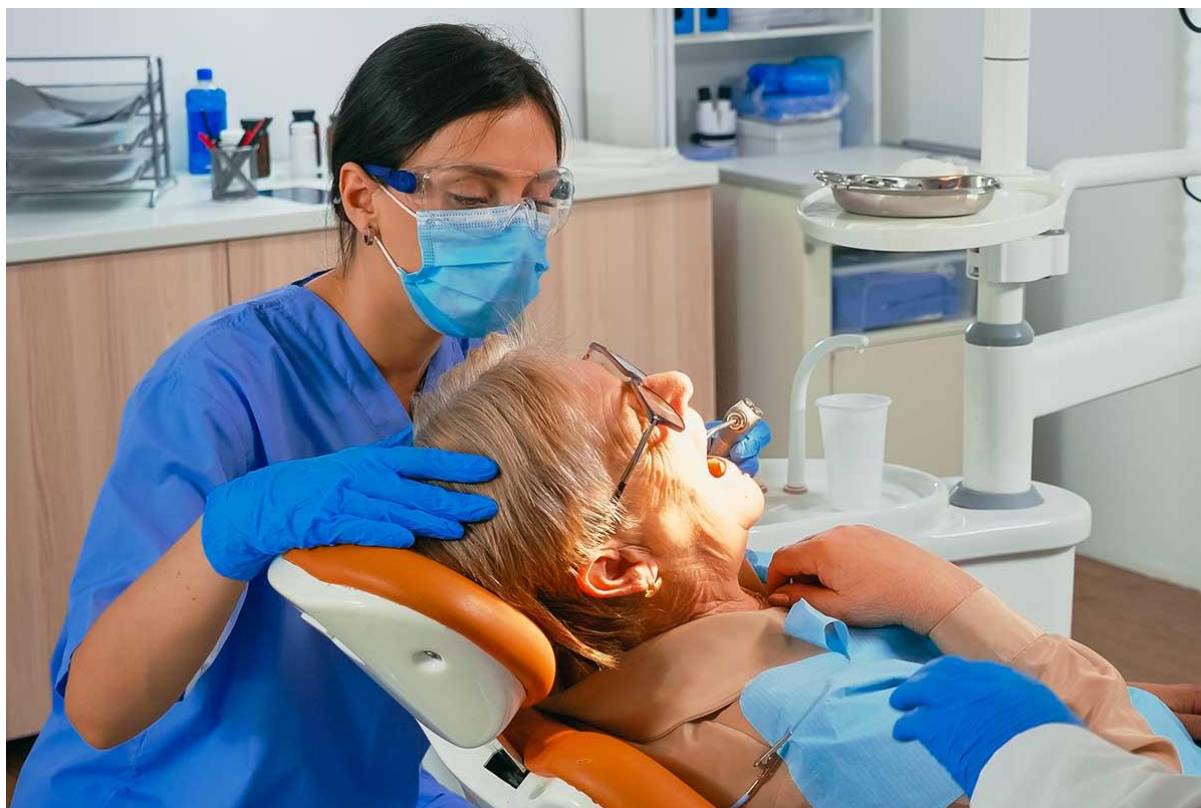


How to Be Prepared With An Emergency Dentist?
