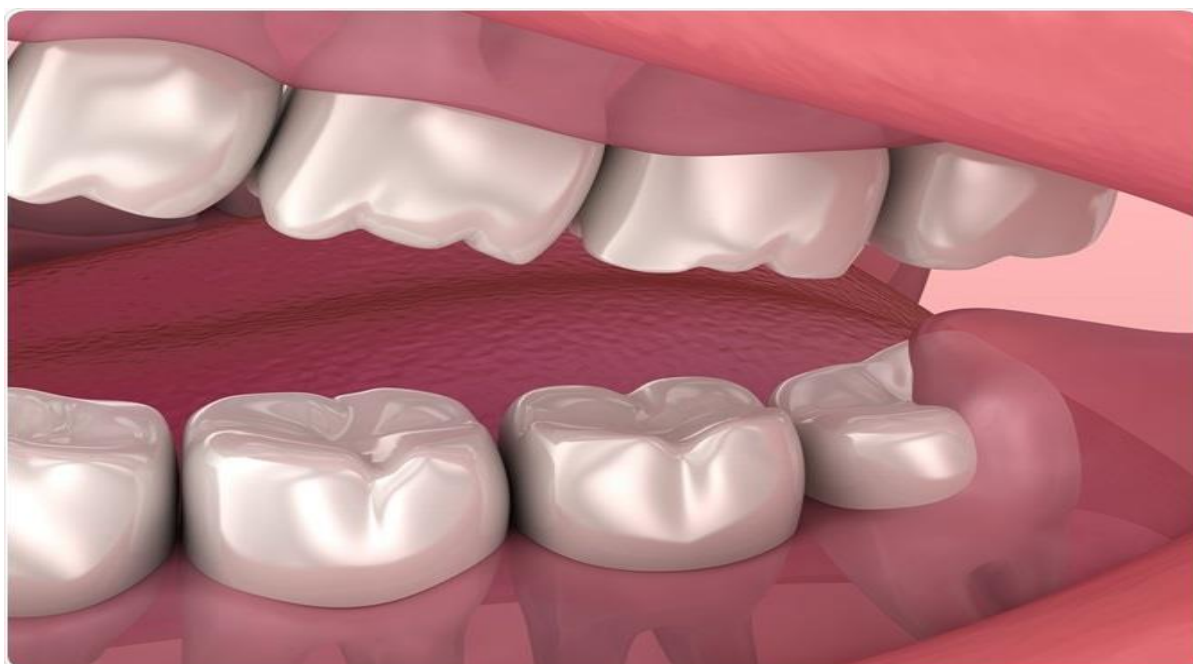


How Long Does Periodontitis Take To Heal?

What is periodontitis?

The term periodontitis means inflammation near the teeth. As there are critical types of periodontal disease also known as gum disease, and damages the pink tissue carrying the teeth in place. Further, the possible issues go beyond the inflamed gums, too. If you do not get [periodontitis treatment](#), then this will cause harm to your bones in the mouth and lead to tooth loss. Typically one may also need steps to prevent serious problems.

What are the signs of periodontitis?

Periodontitis Symptoms must include:

1. Teeth that have-
 - Sensitive feeling
 - Surrounded with a pus
 - Get loose teeth
 - Longer with the gum recession
2. Gums that-
 - Recede
 - Bleed
 - Tender, swollen, and grow red
3. Other signs that need to be included are-
 - Pain while chewing
 - Bad breath
 - Changes in the bite



What are the causes of periodontal disease?

Periodontal diseases are caused by the following points-

- Plaque formation on the teeth
- The infection of the gum will cause periodontitis
- Also, the plaque will tough the gumline into the tartar
- Further, the plaque will lead causing the gingivitis

What is periodontitis treatment?

If the gingivitis develops into periodontitis, then the treatment becomes more difficult. Then only the dentist would conduct the **periodontal disease treatment**, which consists of the special dental methods that need oral surgery. If the healthcare examines that you have periodontitis, then the treatment may rely on the severity of the infections. These options are as follows-

- Flap Surgery
- Doxycycline Gel
- Minocycline Microspheres
- Tooth Scaling and Root Planing
- Chlorhexidine Chip
- Grafts
- Doxycycline Pill

How is periodontitis diagnosed?

The **periodontitis near me** would be diagnosed with the help of dentists. The dentists will-

1. Ask you to show a medical history and signs of the diseases
2. Scan the gums for the symptoms of inflammation
3. The dentists will use a special ruler to check the pockets near the teeth. Note- it would not hurt the patients.
4. Performs an x-ray to check the bone loss.
5. Maybe refer you to a periodontist, a professional in [gum disease treatment](#).

What is the prevention of periodontitis?

The periodontitis or **gingivitis treatment** is preventable. The patients need to take a few steps in preventing the gum diseases and they are-

- Floss regularly
- Avoid smoking
- Brushing a tooth twice a day.
- Have regular dental cleaning and checkups.
