What Are Dental Implants?

Dental implants can be used as a whole mouth alternative to tooth replacement with dental recommendations. But if someone has few or no teeth, the dentist uses dentures over the implants for better adhesive support. Sometimes **nearest dentist office** might use mini-implants to support a complete set of dentures and components of implants. The dental implant procedure involves three primary parts: the implant, abutment, and crown.



Implant

The implant behaves like a tooth's root, providing strength and support to your jaw bones and surrounding teeth. It is made of a titanium post, surgically implanted into your jaw bone.

Abutment

The abutment of your implants holds the prosthetic tooth. Then [Dentist Houston TX](#) screws the remaining part of your abutment into the jawbone.

Crown

The crown is the part you can see about your tooth, and it's like a pseudo tooth. Although affordable variation also exists, they are made of porcelain or white ceramic. Your dentist places a crown over the abutment.

Benefits of an Implant

Here are some benefits of having a dental implant:

- Dental implants help to boost your self-confidence so that you can smile again.
- It's a hassle-free restoration procedure(unlike removable dentures)
- They will allow you to eat anything
- You don't need to worry about your smile and expression
- It supports your jaw bone and helps in preventing jawbone density
