

## Apollo 11: the first men on the moon



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The lunar module touched down on the moon's Sea of

15 Tranquility. [...] A camera in the Eagle provided live coverage as Armstrong descended down a ladder<sup>5</sup> at 11:56 p.m. on July 20, 1969, and uttered the words, "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind." Aldrin followed twenty minutes later [...].

20 While on the surface, the astronauts set up several experiments, collected samples<sup>6</sup> of lunar soil and rock to bring home, erected a United States flag, and took core samples from the crust. They spoke with US President Richard Nixon, whose voice was transmitted 25 from the White House.
