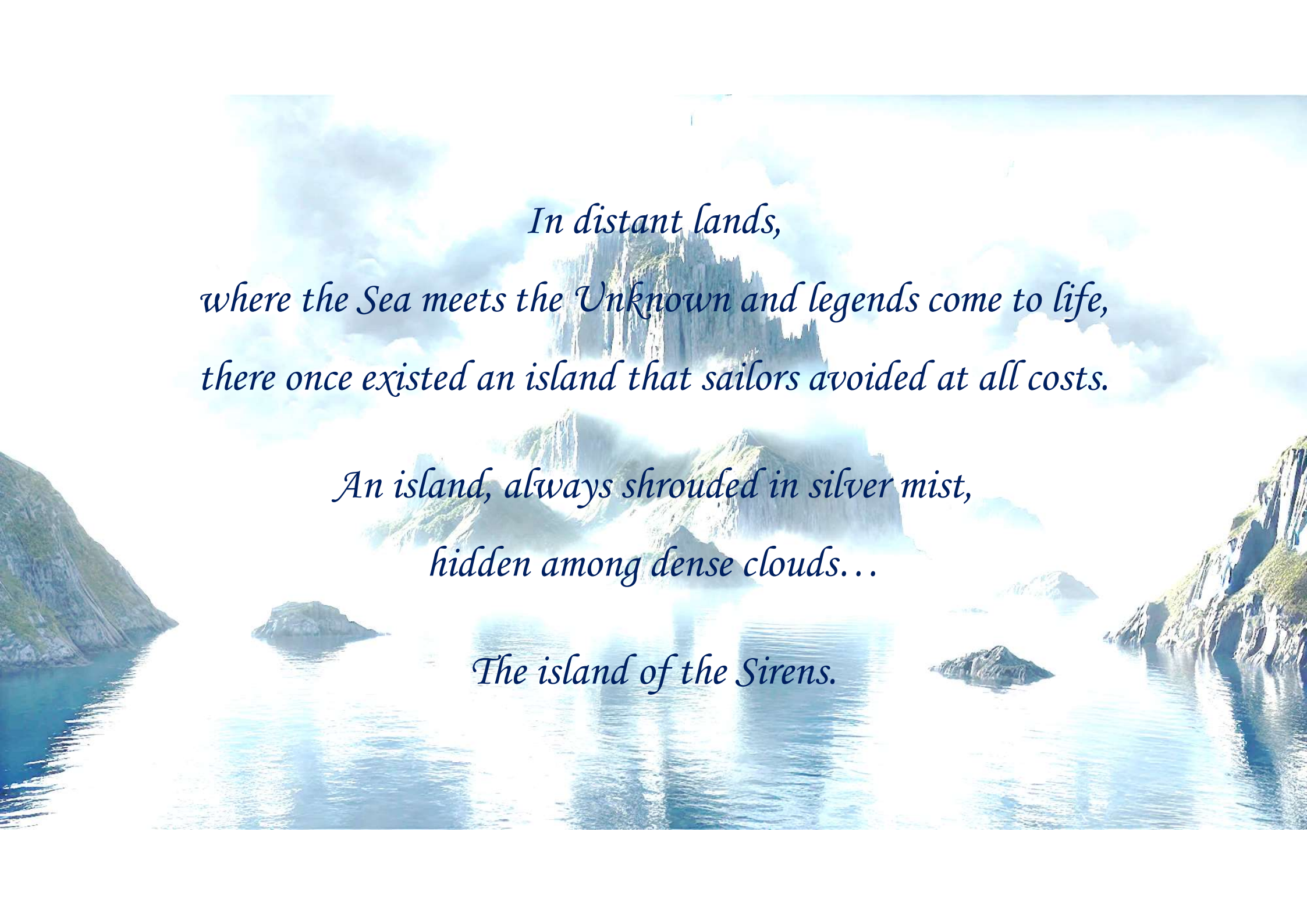




The Legend of the Sirens



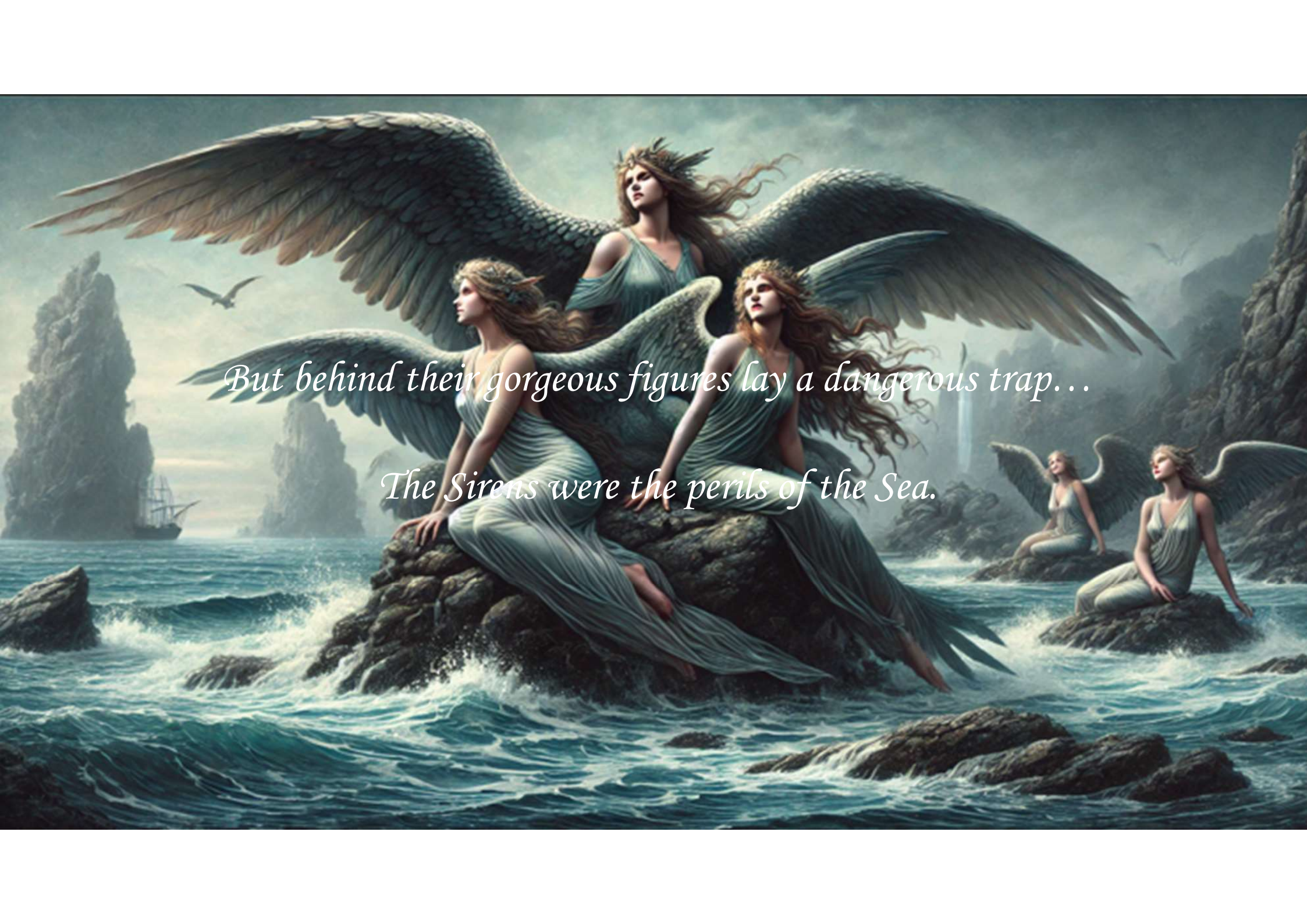
*In distant lands,

and his mind clouding.*

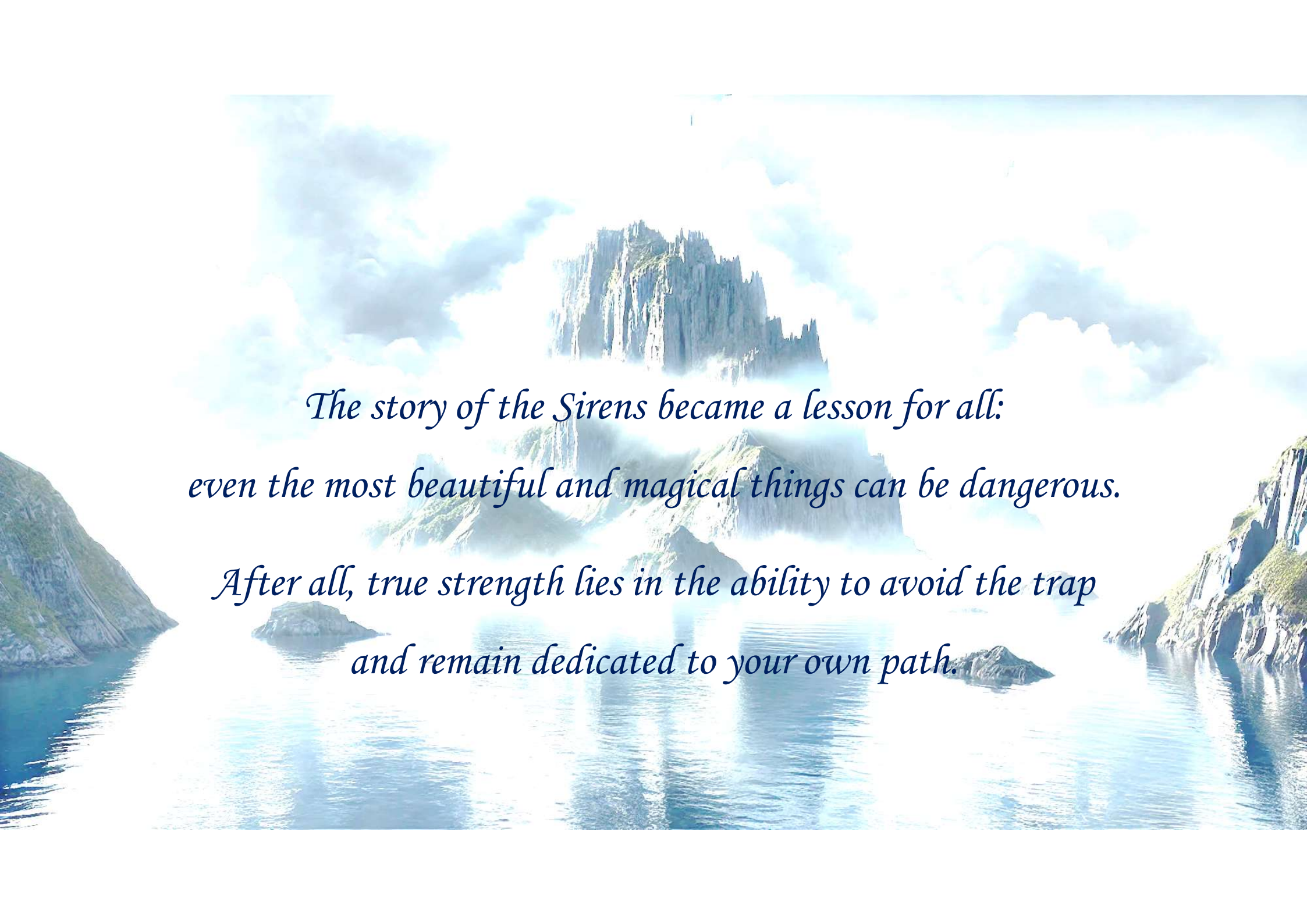
*But because he was bound,
