### SOLVE THE CRIME – MR MILLS (SCRIPT)

**Mrs Mills:** I went to the Odeon in Leicester Square. I had lunch with my friend Gill, but she couldn't come to the film with me, so I left her at 1pm, and I went to the two o'clock performance. (*cries*)

**Inspector:** Can you prove it?

**Mrs Mills:** Yes. I think I have the ticket. Here!

**Inspector:** Thank you Mrs Mills. Now, Mr Ruben, what were you doing between 1 and 2?

**Mr Ruben:** Well, I was driving to Cambridge to meet an associate. At around 1:45, I bought some petrol on the motorway. Here's the receipt. You see, it says 1:47, Monday 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**Inspector:** Thank you. And Miss Pike, what were you doing?

**Miss Pike:** Well, I was shopping. So I was some- where at Harrods.

**Inspector:** Did you buy anything? Have you got a receipt?

**Miss Pike:** I didn't buy anything ... Oh yes I did. I bought a mouse for my computer. I paid with my credit card. Let's see. Here's the receipt!
